**Stripes:** K 1 row, P 1 row with white yarn. K 1 row, P 1 row with violet yarn. K 1 row, P 1 row with white yarn = altogether 3 rills.

#### **SWEATER**

Using circular needle size 7 mm and white yarn, cast on 86-94-98-108 sts. Work in rnds 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm, and cont working in stripes (= 3 rills). Work 7 cm/2.8 in, in St st and white yarn. Place markers each side (= 43-47-49-54 sts for both front and back). Cont working as foll: \*stripes (= 3 rills), 5 cm/2 in in St st, stripes (= 3 rills), 7 cm/2.8 in in St st\*, rep \*-\* until work measures 22-26-30-33 cm/8.7-10.2-11.8-13 in. Bind off at each edge 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Finish back and front separately.

#### Back

Cont working back and forth in St st and stripes. Bind off at each edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures approx. 40-45-50-54 cm/15.7-17.7-19.7-21.3 in, and armhole measures approx. 18-19-20-21 cm/7.1-7.5-7.9-8.3 in. Bind off.

#### Front

Work and bind off for armhole same as for back. When work measures approx. 35-40-44-48 cm/13.8-15.7-17.3-18.9 in, bind off mid 7-9-9-10 sts. Work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 2,1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off.

#### Sleeves

Using needles size 7 mm and white yarn, cast on 20-20-22-22 sts. Work 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in rnds in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm, and adjust the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 24-26-26-28 sts. Cont working in St st and stripes: \*4 rnds in St st, 3 rills\*, rep \*-\* until end. Place a marker underarm, and inc 1 st on each side of the marker approx. every 3 cm/1.2 in until you have 42-46-48-50 sts on the rnd. Bind off underarm 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1,1 sts. Bind off rem sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

**Collar:** Using needles size 7 mm and white yarn, pick or knit up approx. 44-46-48-48 sts around neck edge. Work approx. 4-

4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in K1,P1 rib. Next rnd: M1P into each p-st. Cont working in K1,P2 rib. Bind off when collar measures approx. 13-15-15-17 cm/5.1-5.9-5.9-6.7 in. Sew on the sleeves.

#### Lazy Daisy st

Sew chain sts, using violet yarn, see sketch.

#### HAT

Using needles size 7 mm and white yarn, cast on 52-56 sts. Work 6-6 cm/2.4-2.4 in, in K1,P1 rib. Cont working \*4 rnds in St st, 3 rills with stripes\*, rep \*-\* until work measures approx.20-22 cm/7.9-8.7 in (or desired length). Beg crown dec: \*K2, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: \*K1, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd = 26-28 sts. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 12-13 sts. Work 1 rnd without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 6-7 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, and pull tightly. Weave in ends on WS.

Using circular needle size 7 mm and green yarn, cast on 86-94-98-108 sts. Work in rnds 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm and light blue yarn. Cont working in St st. Place markers each side (= 43-47-49-54 sts for both front and back). When work measures approx. 22-26-30-33 cm/8.7-10.2-11.8-13 in, bind off at each edge 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Finish back and front separately.

### Back

Cont working back and forth in St st. Bind off at each edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures approx. 40-45-50-54 cm/15.7-17.7-19.7-21.3 in, and armhole measures approx. 18-19-20-21 cm/7.1-7.5-7.9-8.3 in. Bind off.

#### **Front**

Work and bind off for armhole same as for back. When work measures approx. 35-40-44-48 cm/13.8-15.7-17.3-18.9 in, bind off mid 7-9-9-10 sts. Work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every  $2^{\text{nd}}$  row 2,1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off.

#### **Sleeves**

**Stripes:** Work 3 cm/1.2 in in each clr, \*light blue, blue and green\*, rep \*-\* until end.

Using needles size 7 mm and green yarn, cast on 18-20-22-22 sts. Work 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in rnds in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm, and adjust the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 24-26-26-28 sts. Cont working in St st and stripes. Place a marker underarm, and inc 1 st on each side of the marker approx. every 3 cm/1.2 in until you have 42-46-48-50 sts on the rnd. Bind off underarm 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1,1 sts. Bind off rem sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams. Sew on the sleeves.

**Neck border:** Using needles size 7 mm and green yarn, pick or knit up approx. 44-46-48-48 sts around neck edge. Work 6 rnds in Garter st. Bind off.

#### HAT, 4/6 8/10 yrs

Using needles size 7 mm and light blue yarn, cast on 52-56 sts. Work 6-6 cm/2.4-2.4 in, in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm. Cont working in St st. When work measures approx.20-22 cm/7.9-8.7 in (or desired length), beg crown dec: \*K2, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: \*K1, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd = 26-28 sts. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 12-13 sts. Work 1 rnd without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 6-7 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, and pull tightly. Weave in ends on WS.

#### **SWEATER**

Using circular needle size 7 mm and green yarn, cast on 86-94-98-108 sts. Work in rnds 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm and pink yarn. Cont working in St st. Place markers each side (= 43-47-49-54 sts for both front and back). When work measures approx. 22-26-30-33 cm/8.7-10.2-11.8-13 in, bind off at each edge 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Finish back and front separately.

#### **Back**

Cont working back and forth in St st. Bind off at each edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures approx. 40-45-50-54 cm/15.7-17.7-19.7-21.3 in, and armhole measures approx. 18-19-20-21 cm/7.1-7.5-7.9-8.3 in. Bind off.

## **Front**

Work and bind off for armhole same as for back. When work measures approx. 35-40-44-48 cm/13.8-15.7-17.3-18.9 in, bind off mid 7-9-9-10 sts. Work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every  $2^{\text{nd}}$  row 2,1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off.

#### Sleeves

**Stripes:** Work 1 rnd in each clr, \*pink, light pink, green\*, rep \*-\* until end.

Using needles size 7 mm and green yarn, cast on 20-20-22-22 sts. Work 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in rnds in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm, and adjust the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 24-26-26-28 sts. Cont working in St st and stripes. Place a marker underarm, and inc 1 st on each side of the marker approx. every 3 cm/1.2 in until you have 42-46-48-50 sts on the rnd. Bind off underarm 4 sts (= 2 sts on

both side of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1,1 sts. Bind off rem sts.

**Finishing:** Sew shoulder seams.

**Neck border:** Using needles size 7 mm and green yarn, pick or knit up approx. 44-46-48-48 sts around neck edge. Work 6 rnds in Garter st. Bind off. Sew on the sleeves.

#### HAT, 4/6 8/10 yrs

Using needles size 7 mm and green yarn, cast on 44-50 sts. Work 6-6 cm/2.4-2.4 in, in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm and pink yarn. Cont working in St st, and adjust the number of sts evenly across 1<sup>st</sup> rnd to be 54-58 sts. When work measures approx.27-32 cm/10.6-12.6 in, bind off. Twist 3 cords, 1 in each clr, and around the top opening to form a 4-5 cm/1.4-2 in tassel.

Cont working in rib with stripes: 1 rnd in green, 2 rnds in white, 1 rnd in green and 4 rnds in turquoise. Change to needles size 8 mm and K 1 rnd. Cont working in St st and patt as charted. pink yarn. Place markers each side (= 42-44-47-50 sts for both front and back). When work measures approx. 24-28-32-36 cm/9.4-11-12.6-14.2 in, bind off at each edge 6 sts (= 3 sts on both side of the marker). Put the piece aside, and knit the sleeves.

#### Sleeves

Using needles size 7 mm and turquoise yarn, cast on 20-20-22-22 sts. Work 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in rnds in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm, and adjust the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 24-26-26-28 sts. Cont working in St st. Place a marker underarm, and inc 1 st on each side of the marker approx. every 3 cm/1.2 in until you have 38-40-44-46 sts on the rnd. Bind off underarm 6 sts (= 3 sts on both side of the marker). Put the piece aside. Work same for the other sleeve.

### Yoke

SI sleeves in (= where the sts were bound off for armholes) on the same circular needle size 8 mm as the body piece = 136-144-158-168 sts. Cont working in rnds in St st, with dec at 4 raglan seam lines: K until 3 sts rem before 1<sup>st</sup> seam line, \*K2togtbl, K2, K2tog\*, rep \*\_\* at every seam line. Rep dec every 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd altogether 12-13-14-15 times = 4040-46-48 sts. Change to white yarn, K 1 rnd, work 1 rnd in K1,P1 rib. Change to green yarn, and work 3 cm/1.2 in, in K1,P1 rib. Bind off.

Finishing: Sew underarm seams.

Using circular needle size 7 mm and light violet yarn, cast on 104-108-114-120 sts. Work 2 rows in Seed st. Change to pink yarn, and work 1 row in Seed st. Change to needles size 8 mm and light grey yarn. Place markers each side (= 27-28-30-32s sts for both fronts, 50-52-54-56 sts for back). Cont working in St st and patt: 5 sts in Seed s, 19 sts in patt as charted, cont working in St st until 24 sts rem, 19 sts in patt as charted, 5 sts in Seed st. Cont working back and forth until work measures approx. 27-31-35-39 cm/10.6-12.2-13.8-15.4 in. Make 1 button hole on right front border: work 2 sts, bind off next 2 sts (Next row: cast on 2 sts over the bound-off sts), work rem sts in patt and St st. Make altogether 3 buttonholes approx. 5 cm/2 in spaced apart. When work measures approx. 29-33-37-41 cm/11.4-13-14.6-16.1 in, bind off at each edge 6 sts (= 3 sts on both side of the marker). Finish back and fronts separately.

#### **Back**

Cont working back and forth in St st. Bind off at each edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures approx. 45-50-55-60 cm/17.7-19.7-21.7-23.6 in, and armhole measures approx. 16-17-18-19 cm/6.3-6.7-7.1-7.5 in. Bind off.

## Right front

Work and bind off for armhole same as for back (**Note!** Remember the buttonholes). When work measures approx. 40-44-49-54 cm/15.7-17.3-19.3-21.3 in, bind for neck edge 6-6-7-8 sts. Bind off at neck edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 2,1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off.

#### Left front

Work same as for right front, rev all shaping.

#### Sleeves

Using needles size 7 mm and light violet yarn, cast on 20-20-22-22 sts. Work 2 rows in Seed st. Change to pink yarn, and work 1 row in Seed st. Change to needles size 8 mm, K 1 rnd, and adjust the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 24-26-26-28 sts. Cont working in St st and patt: 4-5-5-6 sts in St st, 16 sts in patt as charted, 4-5-5-6 sts in St st. Place a marker underarm, and inc 1 st on each side of the marker approx.

every 4 cm/1.6 in until you have 38-40-44-46 sts on the rnd. Bind off underarm 6 sts (= 3 sts on both side of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1,1 sts. Bind off rem sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

Collar: Using needles size 7 mm and light grey yarn, pick or knit up approx. 45-45-49-49 sts around neck edge. Work 7 cm/2.8 in, in Seed st. Inc 1 st beg of each row. Change to pink yarn, work 1 row. Change to light violet yarn, work 1 row. Bind off rather loosely. Sew on the sleeves. Weave in ends on WS. Sew on buttons.

Cont working in patt as charted. When work measures approx. 22-26-30-33 cm/8.7-10.2-11.8-13 in. Bind off at each edge 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Finish back and front separately.

#### Back

Cont working back and forth in patt. Bind off at each edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures approx. 40-45-50-54 cm/15.7-17.7-19.7-21.3 in, and armhole measures approx. 18-19-20-21 cm/7.1-7.5-7.9-8.3 in. Bind off.

## **Front**

Work and bind off for armhole same as for back. When work measures 35-40-44-48 cm/13.8-15.7-17.3-18.9 in, bind off mid 7-9-9-9 sts. Work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 2,1,1 sts (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off.

## **Sleeves**

Using needles size 7 mm and red yarn, cast on 20-20-22-22 sts. Work 4-4-5-5 cm/1.6-1.6-2-2 in, in rnds in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 8 mm, and adjust the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 24-26-26-28 sts. \*Work in Garter st: 1 rill in yellow, 1 rill in blue and 1 rill in green, and 8-10-10-12 rnds in St st with red yarn\*, rep \*-\* until end. Place a marker underarm, and inc 1 st on each side of the marker approx. every 3 cm/1.2 in until you have 42-44-46-48 sts on the rnd. Bind off underarm 4 sts (= 2 sts on both side of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1,1 sts. Bind off rem sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

**Neck border:** Using needles size 7 mm and yellow yarn, pick or knit up approx. 44-46-48-48 sts around neck edge. Work in Garter st: 1 rill in yellow, 1 rill in blue and 1 rill in green. K 1

rnd with red yarn. Bind off 7-7-9-9 mid front sts. Cont working back and forth 3 rows in K1,P1 rib, adjusting the number of sts evenly across 1<sup>st</sup> row to be 56-58-62-64 sts. Cont working in St st, and adjust the number of sts to be 58-62-64-66 sts. Bind off 1 st at each edge every 4<sup>th</sup> row 4 times = 52-54-56-58 sts. When hood measures approx. 18-20-20-22 cm/7.1-7.9-7.9-8.7 in, dec mid back: K22-24-26-29, K2tog, K2, K2togtbl, K22-24-26-28. Rep dec every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 3 times. Bind off, or sl sts onto a holder. Join top seam. Crochet 1 row sc around front edge. Next row: \*Ch3, skip 1 sc, 1 sc to next st\*, rep \*-\*. Twist a cord using all clrs, thread into ch-sts. Sew on the sleeves. Weave in ends on WS.
