## Bolero

1210-1

Size:	One size
Length, approx.	25cm
	9.8 in

**ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Fox4you (97% Rayon – 3% Polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 702 4 balls

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0 + 1m/39.4 in narrow silk ribbon.

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

### **BOLERO**

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 80 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st, and bind off 1 st beg of each row 20 times (10 times at each edge). Bind off 2 sts beg of each row 8 times (4 times at each side) and after that 4 sts beg of each row 6 times (3 times at each side) = 20 sts on a row. Bind off.

Using the cast-on tail, fasten the corner of cast-on edge to first st of the bound-off edge. Using the bound-off tail, fasten the corner of bound-off edge to last st of cast-on edge = 2 armholes. Fasten silk ribbon (use sewing thread) to one armhole edge, and sew along cast-on edge until the other armhole edge (edge with silk ribbon curves around neck edge).

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you.

**ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Fox4you (97% Rayon – 3% Polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr, 722 10 balls

Circular needle or pair of knitting needles size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min 3 m/118.2 in when starting a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

## SCARF

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 25 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until you have finished all 10 balls of yarn. Take care that you leave enough yarn for binding off. Bind off.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

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# Viking Fox4you

## Necklet

1210-3

Size	Woman
Length mid front: approx.	45-50 cm
	17.7-19.7 in

**ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Fox4you (97% Rayon – 3% Polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 792 8 balls

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

## NECKLET

Beg from upper edge. Using needles size 8mm, cast on 48 sts. Work in rnds 10 cm/4 in in St st. Place markers mid front and back. Cont working in rnds in St st, and inc 1 st both sides of the markers **every** rnd altog 5 times, and then **every 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd**. Cont inc until all 8 balls are used (take care to leave enough yarn for binding off). Bind off very loosely. Weave in all ends on WS. Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

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# Viking Fox

## Round shawl

1210-4

Size	Woman
<b>ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Fox4you (97% Rayon – 3% Polyamide), 50 g ball</b>	

Clr, 510 9 balls

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – U/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min. 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

## SHAWL

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 90 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until work measures approx. 30 cm/11.8 in (or all 9 balls have been used). Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off rather loosely. Sew short edges tog, forming a ring, but turn the other side upside down before sewing. Shawl twists mid front. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you

## Viking Fox4you

### Hat, necklet and wristwarmers 1210-5

**Size** **Woman**  
**YARN: Viking Fox4you (97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

#### HAT

Clr 702 3 balls

#### WRISTWARMERS

Clr 702 2 balls

#### NECKLET

Clr 702 3 balls

Short circular needle 40 cm/15.7 in and double pointed needles size 8 – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx, 10cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min 3m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

#### HAT

Using a short circular needle size 8 mm, cast on 52 sts. Work in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 18 cm/7.1 in. Beg crown dec: \*K2, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: \*K1, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Work 1 rnd without dec. Knit all sts tog in pairs every 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd until 13 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, weave in on WS.

#### WRISTWARMERS

Beg from upper edge. Using dpn size 8 mm, cast on 22 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in St st. Place markers each side, 11 sts for each side. Beg from sidemarker, bind off for thumb opening as foll: K1, bind off 3 sts (next rnd: cast on 3 sts over the bound-off sts), and work until the end of the rnd. Cont working in St st until wristwarmer measures the desired length, or yarn is finished. Bind off (Note: Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off)

Work same for the other wristwarmer.

Weave in all ends on WS.

#### NECKLET

Using circular needle size 8 mm, cast on 66 sts. Work in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 25 cm/9.8 in, or all 3 balls are finished. Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off rather loosely.

Use a wool needle, and weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also

spray the fur slightly with water.

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you.

## Viking Fox

### Hat with a pompon

### 1210-6

**Size** **Woman**  
**YARN: Viking Fox4you (97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 702

3 balls

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min. 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

#### HAT

Using needles size 8mm, cast on 52 sts. Work in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 20 cm/7.9 in. Beg crown dec: \*K2, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Work 1 rnd without dec. Rep dec every 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd with 1 st less between dec until 13 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tightly, and weave in on WS. Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

All garments knitted from Viking Fox4you are washable.

#### Pompon

**Note:** Knit pretty tightly so that sts don't fall off from needles.

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 4 sts. Knit 1 rnd, and inc number of sts to be 8 st. Next rnd: Inc number of sts to be 16 sts, and divide sts evenly on 4 dpn. Knit 1 rnd. Next rnd: Inc number of sts to be 24 sts. Knit 4 rnds. Next rnd: Dec number of sts to be 16 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Next rnd: Dec number of rnds to be 8 sts. Last rnd: Knit all sts tog in pairs = 4 sts. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tightly, and weave in on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min. 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

## SHAWL

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 72 – 80 – 88 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st. Place a marker in the middle, 36 – 40 – 44 sts for each side. When work measures 2 cm/0.8 in \*work until 8 sts rem, turn, work until 8 sts rem at the other edge. Turn, work across the row, and inc 1 st both sides of the marker \*. Cont working over all sts. When work measures 4 cm/1.6 in (measured from upper edge), rep \*-\*. Cont working over all sts. When work measures 6 cm/2.4 in (measured from upper edge), rep \*-\*. Cont working over all sts. When work measures 8 cm/3.1 in (measured from upper edge), rep \*-\*. Cont working over all sts. When work measures 10 cm/4 in (measured from upper edge), rep \*-\*, but turn when 10 sts rem at each edge, and cont turning with 2 sts less on each row, **same time** inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2 cm/0.8 in (measured mid back). When shawl measures approx. 30 – 32 – 35 cm/11.8-12.6-13.8 in (measured mid back), work 1 row over all sts. Bind off rather loosely. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you

## Viking Fox4you

### Hood with scarf

1210-8

**Size** **Woman**  
**YARN: Viking Fox4you ( 97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 705 10 balls

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0  
+ optional: 1,5 m/49 in silk ribbon

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

#### HOOD WITH SCARF

Beg from lower edge. Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 12 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until work measures approx. 60 cm/23.6 in (or when you have used approx. 2 ½ balls). Cast on 2 sts to one edge (= back), rep every 2<sup>nd</sup> row altog. 5 times = 22 sts. Cont working back and forth until work measures approx. 87 cm/34.3 in (or when you have used approx. 4 ½ balls). Now half of the hood/scarf is ready. Place a marker. Work same for the other side, but when work measures approx. 20 cm/7.9 in measured from the marker, instead of casting on sts, bind off 2 sts every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 5 times = 12 sts rem. Work back and forth in Garter st until work measures same as the other side, or you have used 9 balls (last ball will be used for the front edge around the hood). Bind off.

#### Finishing

Sew mid back seam, also cast-on/bound-off edges (use sewing thread).

#### Front edge:

Using needles size 8 mm, pick or knit up approx. 56 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until you have finished the last ball of yarn (take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off).

Bind off. Fold edge in double, and sew on WS (use sewing thread). If you wish, you can thread silk ribbon into front edge.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

**Size** **Woman**  
**YARN: Viking Fox4you ( 97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 102 1 ball

40 cm/15.7 in long circular needle 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min. 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

#### HEAD BAND

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 52 sts. Work in rnds in St st until you have used all the yarn. Note take care that there is enough yarn for binding off. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

### Scarf

1210-10

**Size** **Woman**  
**YARN: Viking Fox4you ( 97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 792 10 balls

Circular needle or pair of knitting needles size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### **Fox4you**

Work with double yarn min. 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts

#### SCARF

Using needles size 8mm, cast on 25 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until you have finished all 10 balls of yarn. Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Circular needle size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### Fox4you

Work with double yarn min 3 m/118.2 in when starting a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts

#### Shoe decoration e.g for UGGs:

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 30 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until work measures approx. 12 cm/4.7 in (or when you have used 1½ balls). Bind off. Sew short edges tog using sewing thread. Weave in all ends on WS.

Work same for the other shoe decoration.

#### Shoe decoration for high heeled boots:

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 26 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st until one ball of yarn is finished (Note! Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off). Bind off. Sew short edges tog using sewing thread. Weave in all ends on WS.

Work same for the other shoe decoration

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can spray the fur slightly with water

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you

## Viking Fox4you

### Shoe decoration/legwarmer 1210-13

**YARN: Viking Fox4you ( 97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

Clr 792 4 balls

Double pointed needles size 8 mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### Fox4you

Work with double yarn min. 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

#### SHOE DECORATION/LEGWARMER

Using dpn size 8 mm, cast on 36 sts. Work in rnds in St st until you have used 2 balls. Note! Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off. Weave in all ends on WS.

Work same for the other legwarmer.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you

## Viking Fox4you

### Head band, wristwarmers, necklet 1210-14

**YARN: Viking Fox4You ( 97 % rayon, 3 % polyamide), 50 g ball**

#### HEAD BAND

Clr 722 1 ball

#### WRISTWARMERS

Clr 722 2 balls

#### ROUND NECKLET

Clr 722 3 balls

40 and 60 cm/15.7 and 23.6 in long circular needle + double pointed needles size 8mm – US 11 – UK/Canadian 0

**Gauge:** 11 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 8mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

#### Fox4you

Work with double yarn min 3 m/118.2 in when you start a new ball of yarn. You don't need to weave in yarn ends, and you can cut off yarn ends quite close to the sts.

#### HEAD BAND

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 52 sts. Work in rnds in St st until 1 ball of yarn is finished. Note! Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

#### WRISTWARMERS

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 22 sts. Work in rnds until 1 ball of yarn is finished. Note! Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

#### ROUND NECKLET

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 70 sts. Work in rnds in St st until you have finished all 3 balls. Note! Take care that there is enough yarn left for binding off. Bind off. Weave in all ends on WS.

Brush the fur (a wooden comb is recommended). You can also spray the fur slightly with water.

Dry clean only on all garments knitted from Fox4you
