Double pointed needles size 6 mm (7 pcs) – US 10 - UK/Canadian 4

Gauge: Before felting: 14 sts using needles size 6 mm = approx. 10 cm (4 in). **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Using needles size 6 mm and red yarn, cast on 3 sts on 3 dpn each (= 9 sts). Work in rnds *K 1 on one needle, 1 yo*, rep *- * 2 times (= 12 sts). Divide sts on 6 needles, 2 sts on each needle. Cont working in rnds, and make 1 yo end of each needle every 2nd row until the work is completed.

Stripes:

Cont working with red yarn until you have 10 sts on each needle.

Change to light green, and work until you have 15 sts on each needle.

Change to dark red, and work until you have 23 sts on each needle.

Change to dark green, and work until you have 28 sts on each needle.

Change to red, and work until you have 31 sts on each needle.

Change to grey, and work until you have 36 sts on each needle.

Change to dark green, and work until you have 38 sts on each needle.

Change to light green, and work until you have 43 sts on each needle.

Change to dark red, and work until you have 45 sts on each needle.

Change to red, and work until you have 50 sts on each needle.

Bind off.

Weave in all ends on WS.

FELTING

Wash the piece in a washing machine, in 40-60°C fine wash program, adding small amount mild detergent. Bigger objects felt more than smaller ones. Wash smaller pieces together with a towel or pair of jeans. Stretch your work into measurement and shape it while still damp. Afterwards it can be washed in wool wash program. Different washing machines produce different kind of felting result, test first with a swatch.

Circular needle size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 - UK/Canadian 2, crochet hook size 3½ mm – US E/4 - UK/Canadian 9

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Abbreviations:

ch = chain stitch, sl st = slip stitch, sc = single crochet

OCTAGONAL SEAT MAT

Using needles size 7 mm and light beige yarn, cast on 26 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st. Inc 1 st at each edge inside selvage sts every 2nd row until you have altog. 68 sts on a row. Cont working back and forth in Garter st until work measures approx. 27 cm (10.6 in) (measured from cast-on edge). Dec 1 st at each edge inside selvage sts beg of every row until 26 sts rem. Bind off rather loosely. Weave in all ends on WS.

Felting: See 1113-1

Eyes:

Using crochet hook size 3½ mm and black yarn, work as foll:

Make a finger lock, fasten with 1 sl st, 6 sc into ring.

1st rnd: Ch1, 2 sc to each st, end with 1 sl st.

2nd rnd: Same as 1st rnd.

3rd rnd: Ch1, * 1 sc, 2 sc to next st*, rep *-* across the rnd, end with 1 sl st.

4th rnd: Ch1, * 2 sc, 2 sc to next st*, rep *-* across the rnd, end with 1 sl st.

Break yarn, and draw through last st.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Sew eyes on ready-felted seat mat. Using white yarn, embroider 2 rows of stem sts around the eyes. Embroider mouth and nose with stem sts in black.

Make 5 pompons for "hair rolls" using red Sportsgarn (all in same color), diameter approx. 5 cm (2 in). Sew them on top and on slanting sides, 1 in the mid, and 2 on each side (see photo).

Pair of knitting needles and double pointed needles size 10 mm – US 15 -UK/Canadian 000

Gauge, before felting: 10 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 10 mm.

Gauge, after felting: approx. 14 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SLIPPERS

Using pair of knitting needles size 10 mm and beige yarn, cast on 24-30-36 sts. Work 2-3-3 cm (0.8-1.2 in) back and forth in Garter st. Cont working in stripes as foll: 2 rows in brown, 2 rows beige, 2 rows in brown * 2 rows in white, 2 rows beige, 2 rows in brown *, rep *-* until work measures approx. 13-19-21 cm (5.1-7.5-8.3 in). Cont working in rnds in St st with white yarn until work measures 20-26-34 cm (7.9-10.2-13.4 in). Work 2 rnds in St st with beige, then 2 rnds in St st with white. Cont working with brown yarn, and dec as foll: *K2-3-2, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: *K1-2-1, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd = 12-18-18 sts rem. Work 2 rnds in St st. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 6-9-9 sts rem. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts, pull tightly and weave in on WS. Sew mid back seam. Work same for the other slipper.

Short circular needle and double pointed needles size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 - UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 7 mm and double yarn. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Gauge, after felting: approx. 14 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st.

Follow the basic knitting instruction with stripes:

STRIPES, ALTERNATIVE (A)

16 rnds in cherry + dark pink, 6 rnds in dark pink + violet. Cont working in double yarn, dark pink until the end.

STRIPES, ALTERNATIVE (B)

4 rnds in orange, 2 rnds in cherry, 4 rnds in green, 2 rnds in violet, 6 rnds in yellow. Cont working in double yarn, violet until the end.

STRIPES, ALTERNATIVE (C)

6 rnds in violet, 2 rnds in green, 6 rnds in violet. Cont working in violet + green until the end.

BASIC INSTRUCTION FOR GIRL'S HAT

Using needles size 7 mm and double yarn, A = Light pink/cherry, B = cherry, C = violet/green, cast on 102 sts. Work 4 rnds in St st. Next rnd: *K4, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Work 3 rnds. Rep dec one more time, with 3 sts between each dec = 68 sts rem. Cont working in St st and stripes. When work measures approx. 18 cm (7.1 in), beg crown dec: *K2, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: *K1, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 9 sts rem. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tightly and weave in on WS.

Felting: See 1113-1. Stretch the hat into shape while still damp.

Circular needle size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 - UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: Before felting: 14 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SLIPPERS

Using needles size 7 mm and green yarn for woman (or grey for girl), cast on 48-50-54-60-66-74 sts. Work back and forth 10-12-12-16-20-22 rows in Garter st. Cont working with green yarn (change to pink for girl), and work 28-32-40-52-60-68 rows in Garter st over 8-10-12-14-16-18 mid sts. Pick or knit up 15-17-21-27-31-35 sts along each side of the slipper, and work 6-8-10-12-14-16 rows in Garter st over all sts (= 78-84-96-114-128-144 sts). Change to grey yarn for girl 2 rows before starting dec. Dec as foll: K2tog, K32-34-39-47-53-60, K2tog, K6-8-10-12-14-16 (= front), K2tog, K32-34-39-47-53-60, K2tog. Rep dec every 2nd row (1 st less between side dec, and 2 sts less between mid front sts) 2-2-2-2-3-3 times. Rep dec every row until all mid front sts have been decreased (last dec mid front is K2tog twice). Bind off. Sew sole seam, and mid back seam. Work same for the other slipper.

Felting: See 1113-1. Shape the slippers by wearing them while still damp.

Pair of knitting needles and double pointed needles size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 - UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SLIPPERS

Using pair of needles size 7 mm and double yarn (black + turquoise), cast on 24-28-32 sts. Work back and forth 20-24-32 rows in Garter st. Change to dpn, and cont working in rnds in St st. Work *4 rnds in black (double yarn), and 4 rnds in turquoise (double yarn)*, rep *-*. When work measures approx. 21-23-25 cm (8.3-9.3-9.8 in), beg dec: *K2, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. K 1 rnd. Next rnd: K2, K2tog*, rep across the rnd. K 1 rnd. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs. K 1 rnd. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts, pull tightly and weave in on WS. Sew mid back seam. Work same for the other slipper.

Felting: See 1113-1.

ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Alpaca Sport (40% wool, 30% alpaca, 30% nylon), Viking Sportsgarn (100% wool), Viking Sportsragg (60% wool, 20% acrylic, 20% nylon), 50 g balls

Off-White, 102 4 5 balls

Crochet hook size 4 and 5 – US G/6 and H/8 - UK/Canadian 8 and 6

Gauge:

Using crochet hook size 5 mm: 1 motif = approx. 9x9 cm (in), 14 dc x 8,5 rows = 10x10 cm (4x4 in).
Using crochet hook size 4 mm: 17 sc x 20 rows = approx. 10x10 cm (4x4 in).

Work a swatch first. Gauge must match in order to obtain the correct size.

Inc 1 st: Work 2 sts into same st.

Dec 1 st: Work 2 sts tog

Motif: Ch6, join into ring with 1 sl st.

First dc = ch2.

1st rnd: (4 dc, ch3) 4 times into ring, end with 1 sl st to top of first dc.

2nd rnd: *1 dc to each 4 dc, ch3 + 1 dc + ch3 to 3ch-space*, rep *-*, end with 1 sl st to top of first dc.

3rd rnd for motif mid front: (4 dc tog, ch3, skip 3ch-space, 1 dc + ch1 + 1 dc to dc, ch3, skip 3ch-space) 2 times, (4 dc tog, ch3, skip ch3-space, 1 dc + ch1 + 1 tr +

ch1 + 1 dc to dc, ch3, skip 3ch-space) 2 times, end with 1 sl st top of first tr.

3rd rnd for rest of the motifs: *4 dc tog, ch3, skip 3ch-space, 1 dc + ch1 + 1 tr + ch1 + 1 dc to dc, ch3, skip 3ch-space*, rep *-* , end with 1 sl st to top of first tr.

Bobble: Make a loose finger lock, ch3, 3 dc tog into the lock. Break yarn, pull tightly. Tighten the lock, too, and tie the threads tog. Make 4 bobbles per each motif, and sew in the center of the motif.

Felting: Put a small polythene bag inside each slipper. Wash in a washing machine in 60 program. Use normal detergent. Stretch slippers into shape while still damp, leave to dry.

Note! Read through the instruction before getting started.

SLIPPERS

Motif on top of the foot: Using crochet hook size 5 mm, make 3 motifs, (see earlier in the instruction), 1st motif is worked as "3rd rnd for motif mid front", and 2 others as "3rd rnd for rest of the motifs". Sew the 3 motifs tog into a band.

Sole: Using crochet hook size 4 mm, ch7 (7).

1st row: Turn with ch1, 1 sc to each st = 7 (7) sc.

2nd row: Turn with ch1, 1 sc to each st, but inc 1 st to first and last st = 9 (9) sc.

Rep 1st -2nd row until you have altog. 17 (19) sc on a row.

Cont working in sc without inc, turn each time with ch1.

When sole measures approx. 23 (25) cm (9.1 (9.8) in), dec 1 st at each edge every 2nd row until 7 (7) sc rem.

Sole measures approx. 28 (31) cm 11 (11 (12.2) in). Break yarn.

Slipper: Worked using crochet hook size 5 mm. First dc each rnd = ch2, end row with 1 sl st to top of first dc. Place markers mid back = mid 7 ch sts in the beg, and mid 7 sts on last row = mid front.

Fasten yarn mid back with 1 sl st.

1st row: 94 (106) dc evenly across the sole, 47 (53) dc each side.

2nd row: Turn, 1 dc to each dc.

Rep 2nd row until you have worked altog. 3(4) dc-rows.

Next row: 27 (32) dc, 3 dc tog = dec 2 sts.

Turn, 3 dc tog, 1 dc to each st, = dec 2 sts. Con working in the same way, dec 2 sts every row, until 22 (24) dc rem.

Cont working without dec until work measures approx. 29 (29) cm (11.4 (11.4) in), measured mid front.

Work same for the other side, starting from mid back.

Finishing: Join motif band to the slipper, work as foll, beg from side nearest to you. Using crochet hook size 4 mm, work in sc. Turn, and work for the edge as foll: *ch4, skip 1 st, (1 sl st to next st) 2 times*, rep *-* across the joining rnd.

Sew mid back seam.

Work 1 row sc to the upper edge of the slipper, work for the edge same as earlier. Work same for the other slipper.

ALTERNATIVE YARN: Viking Naturgarn (100% wool), Viking Alpaca Superfine (100% alpaca), 50 g ball

Multicolor, 670 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 4 - 4 - 4 balls

Double pointed needles size 8 mm – US 11 - UK/Canadian 0

Crochet hook size 8 mm – US L/11 - UK/Canadian 0

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 8 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SLIPPERS

Using needles size 8 mm, cast on 36 - 38 - 40 - 42 - 44 - 46 - 48 - 50 sts. P 1 row. Cont working in St st with inc/dec as foll:

1. Bind off 3 sts at each edge beg of each row 2 times. Work 1 row over 24 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 32 - 34 - 36 - 38 sts.
2. Next row (= WS), cast on 3 sts at each edge beg of each row 2 times (= same number of sts as on cast-on row).
3. Same as 1.
4. Same as 2.

Cont working in the same way until you have worked altog. 18 - 18 - 18 - 23 - 23 - 23 - 27 - 27 rows.

Notice that some sizes end with 1 = bind-offs, and some with 2 = cast-ons. Sizes that end with 2: slip first and last 6 sts on holder (for joining later on). Cont working in rnds in St st with rem sts. Adjust over the first rnd the number of sts to be 24 - 28 - 28 - 32 - 32 - 36 - 36 - 40 sts. Rnd begins and ends on top of the foot. Work 10 - 11 - 13 - 12 - 14 - 16 - 16 - 18 rnds.

Beg dec:

K2, K2tog, rep *-* across the rnd.

Work 1 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 3 - 3 rnds without dec.

K1, K2tog, rep *-* across the rnd.

Work 1 - 1 - 1 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 rnds without dec.

K all sts tog in pairs.

12 - 12 - 14 - 14 - 16 - 16 - 18 - 18 sts rem.

Work 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 rnds without dec.

K all sts tog in pairs.

Break yarn, and thread through rem sts.

Sew mid back seam.

Felting: See 1113-1.

Wear slippers while still damp, and shape them into form.

1-COLORED

Dark Grey, 615 4 balls

Pair of knitting needles size 10 mm – US 15 - UK/Canadian 000

Gauge, before felting: 10 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 10 mm - US - UK/Canadian

Check your gauge to ensure success.

Gauge, after felting: approx. 14 sts over St st measure approx. 10 cm (4 in).

SLIPPERS (Note! Instruction is for 3-colored slippers, but 1-colored are worked in the same way).

Using needles size 10 mm and white yarn, cast on 31-35-39-43 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Cont working back and forth as foll: 12-13-14-16 sts in Garter st, 7-9-11-11 sts in St st, 12-13-14-16 sts in Garter st. When work measures approx. 8-11-12-13 cm (3.1-4.3-4.7-5.1 in), change to light grey yarn and cont until work measures approx. 10-13-14-15 cm (4-5.1-5.5-5.9 in). Slip 12-13-14-16 sts at each edge on holders. Cont working in St st with light grey yarn over 7-9-11-11 mid sts. When mid part measures approx. 8-11-13-15 cm (3.1-4.3-5.1-5.9 in), slip sts from holders back to work, and divide sts on 3 dpn. Change to dark grey yarn, and cont working in Garter st. Same time, pick or knit up 10-13-15-17 sts along both sides of mid part = 51-61-69-77 sts on a row. Work 6-6-8-8 rows in Garter st over all sts. Beg dec: K22-26-29-33, K2tog, K3-5-7-7, K2tog, K22-26-29-33. Next row (= WS): Knit. Next row (= RS): Rep dec with 1-3-5-5 sts between dec. Rep dec every 2nd row until 1 st rem between dec mid front. Bind off rather loosely, or leave sts on holder for joining mid under sole. Weave in all ends on WS.

Sew mid back and sole seam.

Felting: See 1113-1.

Pair of knitting needles size 10 mm – US 15 - UK/Canadian 000

Gauge, before felting: 10 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 10 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Gauge, after felting: approx. 14 sts over St st = approx. 10 cm (4 in).

SLIPPERS

Using needles size 10 mm and multicolor yarn, cast on 31-35-39-43 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Change to pink yarn, and cont working back and forth as foll: 11-13-14-16 sts in Garter st, 9-9-11-11 sts in St st, 11-13-14-16 sts in Garter st. When work measures approx. 12-13-14-15 cm (4.7-5.1-5.5-5.9 in), slip 11-13-14-16 sts at each edge on holders. Cont working in St st over 9-9-11-11 mid sts. When mid part measures approx. 9-11-13-15 cm (3.5-4.3-5.1-5.9 in), slip sts from holders back to work, and divide sts on 3 needles. Cont working in Garter st and heather color yarn. Same time, pick or knit up 11-13-15-17 sts along both sides of mid part. Work 6-6-8-8 rows in Garter st over all sts. Beg dec: K22-26-29-33, K2tog, K7-7-9-9, K2tog, K22-26-29-33. Next row (= WS): Knit. Next row (= RS): Rep dec with 5-5-7-7 sts between dec. Rep dec every 2nd row until 1 st rem between dec mid front. Bind off rather loosely, or leave sts on holder for joining mid under sole. Weave in all ends on WS. Sew cross sts over each side of mid front using multicolor yarn (don't pull the thread too tight because of felting). Sew mid back and sole seam.

Gauge, before felting: 10 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needle size 10 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Gauge, after felting: approx. 14 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st.

SLIPPERS

Using needles size 10 mm, cast on 31-35-39-43 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Cont working back and forth as foll: 12-13-14-16 sts in Garter st, 7-9-11-11 sts in St st, 12-13-14-16 sts in Garter st. When work measures approx. 10-13-14-15 cm (4-5.1-5.5-5.9 in), slip 12-13-14-16 sts at each edge on holders. Cont working in St st over 7-9-11-11 mid sts. When mid part measures approx. 8-11-13-15 cm (3.1-4.3-5.1-5.9 in), slip sts from holders back to work, and divide them on 3 dpn. Cont working in Garter st. Same time, pick or knit up 10-13-15-17 sts along both sides of mid part = 51-61-69-77 sts on a row. Work 6-6-8-8 rows in Garter st over all sts. Work 18 rnds in St st and black yarn, except cont working with 4 p-sts same as before. Change to multicolor yarn, and work 6 rnds in St st.

Change to black yarn, and work the edge of the bottom:

K 1 rnd, adjusting the number of sts evenly across the rnd to be 84 sts.

K 2 rnds, P 1 rnd, K 1 rnd.

Change to multicolor yarn, and K each st tog with a st approx. 4 rnds below (= folding).



P5, P3tog, turn.

K4, K3tog, turn.

P4, P2tog, turn.

K4, K2tog, turn.

P4, P2tog, turn.

Bind off, and at same time K4, K2tog. Break yarn, and thread through last st.

Side piece “B”

Using beige yarn, knit up 51 sts along edge “B” (RS).

Work same as for side piece A, but don't break yarn in the end. Slip the rem st on crochet hook.

Using a crochet hook, work (RS) 1 row sl sts along edge “C” (front). Break yarn, and thread through last st.

Flap:

Using white yarn, pick or knit up approx. 27 sts along edge “D”.

1st row (= WS): K2, P until 2 sts rem, K2, and adjust the number of sts across the row to be 40 sts. Work 9 rows in St st inside 3 selvage sts at each edge worked in Garter st. Cont working in the same way, but dec 2 sts beg of each row within 3 selvage sts. When 8 sts rem, work 6 rows in Garter st. Bind off, and weave in all ends on WS.

Loops for carabine hooks:

Using white yarn, cast on 8 sts. Work 14 rows in St st, ending with WS row, change to beige yarn and work 4 rows in St st. Thread through carabine hook. WS: K sts tog with cast-on sts, and bind off at the same time. Work same for the other loop.

Thread cord through the loops for felting process – will be replaced by leather bands later on.

Felting: See 1113-1.

Roll few towels and stuff them inside the bag to obtain the correct shape. When the bag is dry, add all accessories.

Bottom and sides:

Using dark grey yarn, knit up (RS) 1 st from back of each loop on sides “A”, “B” and “C”, triangles 3 and 4 = approx. 54 sts. P 1 row, adjusting the number of sts to be 81 sts. Cont working as foll:

**RS: Knit.

WS: K1, *K1,P1*, rep *-* and end the row with K2.**. Rep **-** for altog. 9 rows, ending with RS row.

Sl sts on holder, and put the piece aside.

Work same for bottom and sides for triangles 1 and 2. Knit up sts from sides “E”, “F” and “G”.

Joining of bottom and sides:

K sts of the 2 pieces tog in pairs and bind off at the same time.

Flap:

Knit up approx. 22 sts, using grey yarn across WS of side “D”.

P 1 row, adjusting the number of sts to be 29 sts. Cont working 12 rows in patt as described earlier. Dec 1 st beg of each RS row. When 22 sts rem, bind off 15 sts on WS row. 
Picture 2: Sew handles together

Cont working in St st (with stripes) until work measures approx. 7-8-9-10 cm (2.8-3.1-3.5-4 in). Place a marker = all measurements are given from here. Cont working in rnds, and beg inc for thumb at one side: M1, K2, M1. Work 2 rnds without inc. Rep inc every 3rd rnd with 2 sts more between inc, until you have 8-8-10-10 sts for thumb. Slip the inc sts on holder/thread, and cast on 4-4-6-6 new sts. Cont working in St st until work measures approx. 15-17-19-21 cm (5.9-6.7-7.5-8.3 in) (measured from the marker) (Striped mittens: Cont working in orange until the end). Beg dec: *K2, K2tog*, rep *-* across rnd. K 3 rnds without dec. Next rnd: *K1, K2tog*, rep *-* across rnd. K 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs. K 2 rnds. K all sts tog in pairs until 5-6-7-7 sts rem. Break the yarn and thread through rem sts, and pull tightly. Weave in ends on WS.

Thumb: (Striped mittens: Thumb is worked with orange yarn) Using dpn size 5 mm, pick up sts on holder/thread and pick 5-5-6-6 sts from the cast-on sts + 1 st each side = 15-15-18-18 sts. Work 6-7-8-8 cm (2.4-2.8-3.1-3.1 in) in St st. Beg dec: K all sts tog in pairs until 8-8-9-9 sts rem. Break the yarn and thread through rem sts, and pull tightly. Weave in ends on WS. Work same for the other mitten, with thumb on the other side. **Felting:** See 1113-1

Using dpn size 6 mm (divided evenly on 4 dpn), cast on 40-50 sts. Work 15-18 rnds in St st. Dec on next 2 rnds 1 st over each needle (= -4 sts). Work 12-14 rnds in St st. Next rnd: Knit in a marker thread for thumb using contrast clr over first/last (left/right hand mitten) 8 sts. Work 34-36 rnds in St st. Beg dec: dec 1 st beg of each needle, rep every 2nd rnd 4 times, and then every rnd until 4 sts rem. Break the yarn and thread through rem sts.

Thumb: Remove the marker thread, and pick up the exposed sts, 8-9 sts from both edges, and 1 st from each side (= 18-20 sts). Work 16-18 rnds in St st. Dec 1 st every rnd until 4 sts rem. Break the yarn and thread through rem sts, and pull tightly.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Work same for the other mitten, with thumb on the other side.

Tip: Place small polythene bags inside the thumbs for the felting process.

K 1 row (= WS) = mid under foot. Work other side in reverse = instead of casting on sts, bind off every 2nd row 4x1, 3x3 and 2-3x5 sts = 32-36 sts. Work approx. 18-20 cm (7.1-7.9 in) without dec. Bind off.

Finishing: Fold slipper in double, wrong sides facing each other. Sew mid back seam. Sew mid front seam, leaving approx. 10 cm (4 in) split. Turn the slipper inside out (= RS). Work same for the other slipper.


