## **Body**

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 116-124-140-148-156 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Cont working back and forth in Garter st. Place markers each side, 60-64-72-76-80 sts for back, and 28-30-34-36-38 sts for each front. Cont working until work measures approx. 81-86-85-89-89 cm/31.9-33.9-33.5-35-35 in. Divide work at sidemarkers, and finish back and fronts separately.

### Back

Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 105-110-110-115-115 cm/ 41.4-43.3-43.3-45.3-45.3 in, and armhole measures approx. 24-24-25-26-26 cm/9.4 -9.4-9.8-10.2-10.2 in. Bind off.

## **Right front**

Work same as for back until work measures approx. 95-100-100-105-105 cm/ 37.4 - 39.4 - 39.4 - 41.4 - 41.4 in. Bind off at neck edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 1x4-4-5-5-5 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1. Cont working until front measures same as back. Bind off.

Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

# **Sleeves**

Using needles 7 mm, cast on 32-32-32-32 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in K4,P4 rib. Cont working in Garter st. Inc 1 st at each edge approx. every  $3\frac{1}{2} - 3\frac{1}{2} - 3$ -3-3 cm/1.4-1.4-1.2-1.2-1.2 in, until there is altog. 58-58-60-62-62 sts on a row. When sleeve measures approx. 50-51-52-52-52 cm/19.7-20.1-20.5-20.5-20.5 in (or desired length), bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

## **Finishing**

Sew shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams.

**Right front band:** Using needles size 7 mm, pick or knit up 116-120-120-128-128 sts (Note! Number of sts must be

multiple by 8 sts). Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Bind off rather loosely. Work same for left front band

**Neck band:** Beg from right front edge, Knit or pick up approx. 60-60-68-68-68 sts (Note! Number of sts must be multiple by 8+4 sts). Work approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Bind off in rib.

Sew on sleeves, and weave in all ends on WS.

Note! Use double yarn for coat, Kid Mohair + Nordlys.

# Body

Using needles size 7 mm and double yarn, cast on 132-140-156-164-180 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Cont working back and forth in St st. Place markers at each side, 68-72-80-84-92 sts for back, and 32-34-38-40-44 sts for each front. When work measures approx. 81-86-85-89-89 cm/31.9-33.9-33.5-35-35 in, divide for armholes, and finish back and fronts separately.

### Back

Cont working in St st until work measures 105-110-110-115-115 cm/41.4-43.3-43.3-45.3-45.3 in, and armholes measure approx. 24-24-25-26-26 cm/9.4-9.4-7.9-10.2-10.2 in. Bind off.

## **Right front**

Cont until work measures approx. 95-100-100-105-105 cm/37.4-39.4-39.4-41.4-41.4 in. Bind off for neck edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> rows: Bind off 1x4-4-5-5-5 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1 st. When front measures same as back, bind off. Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

## Sleeves

Using needles size 7 mm and double yarn, cast on 32-40-40-40-40 sts. Work in rnds 5 cm/2 in in K4,P4 rib (= fold on right when sleeve is ready) Cont working in rnds in St st. Place a marker mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every  $2\frac{1}{2} - 3\frac{1}{2} - 3-3-3$  cm/1 -1.4-1.2-1.2-1.2 in until there is approx. 68-68-70-72-72 sts on a rnd. When work measures 50-51-52-52-52 cm/19.7-20.1-20.5-20.5-20.5 in (incl. folding), bind off.

Work same for the other sleeve.

### **Finishing**

Sew shoulder seams.

**Right front band:** Using needles size 7 mm, pick or knit up 132-140-140-148-148 sts (Note! Number of sts must be multiple with 8 sts). Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Bind off rather loosely. Work same for left front band.

**Collar:** Beg from right front edge, Pick or knit up approx. 50-50-54-54-54 sts. Work back and forth approx. 5 cm/2½ in in K2,P2 rib. Inc 1 st to each knit- and purl-panel. Work in K3,P3 rib until collar measures approx. 10 cm/4 in. Rep inc again, and work in K4,P4 rib until collar measures approx. 15 cm/5.9 in. Bind off extra loosely in rib. Sew on sleeves, and weave in all ends.

### Back

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 64-72-76 sts. Work back and forth 4 rows in K2,P2 rib. Always knit first and last st (= selvage st). Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working back and forth in patt as charted, **but** inc 1 st on first row = 65-73-77 sts. Cont working until back measures 70-70-71 cm/27.6-27.6-28 in. Bind off.

### **Front**

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 64-72-76 sts. Work back and forth 4 rows in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working in patt as charted, **but** inc 1 st on first row = 65-73-77 sts. When work measures approx. 40-40-41 cm/15.7-15.7-16.1 in, bind off 5 mid sts. Finish each side separately.

Beg from right front, and cont working in patt. Dec 1 st (= K2togtbl inside 1 selvage st) beg of every 4<sup>th</sup> row altog 9 times. When work measures approx. 70-70-71 cm/15.7-15.7-16.1 in, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping (= V-neck shaping: Work until 3 sts rem, K2tog, K1).

### **Sleeves**

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 34-34-34 sts. Work back and forth 4 rows in K2,P2 rib (knit first and last st each row = selvage st). Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working in patt as charted, and inc 1 st on first row = 35-35-35 sts. Cont working in patt, and inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 4-3 ½ -3 ½ cm/1.6-1.4-1.4 in, until there is altog. 59-61-63 sts on a row. Cont working until sleeve measures approx. 50-50-51 cm/19.7-19.7-20.1 in (or desired length). Bind off. Sew sleeve seam. Work same for the other sleeve.


### **Finishing**

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams, leaving approx. 12 cm/4.7 in splits on each side, and approx. 24-25-26 cm/9.4-9.8-10.2 in for armholes (measure width from sleeves).

Neck band: Beg from right front, and pick up approx. 94-98-102 sts on needles size 6 mm. Work back and forth approx. 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Bind off in rib.

Place neck band ends on top of each other, and sew sides to V-neck edges. Weave in all ends on WS.

Sew on sleeves.

Note! Use double yarn for coat, Kid Mohair +Alpaca Fine.

### **Body**

Using needles size 7 mm and double yarn, cast on 156-172-188-196-212 sts. Work back and forth in K4,P4 rib. Place markers each side, 80-88-96-104-112 sts for back, and 38-42-46-50-54 sts for each front. Cont working in rib, until work measures approx. 81-86-85-89-89 cm/31.9-33.9-33.5-35-35 in. Divide work at sidemarkers, and finish back and fronts separately.

# Back

Cont working in rib, until work measures 105-110-110-115-115 cm, and armhole measures approx. 24-24-25-26-26 cm/9.4-9.4-7.9-10.2-10.2 in. Bind off.

### **Right front**

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 95-100-100-105-105 cm/37.4-39.4-39.4-41.4-41.4 in, bind off at neck edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 1x5-5-6-6-6 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 2x1 m 2 st. Cont working until front measures same as back. Bind off.

Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

# Sleeves

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 40-40-40-40-40 sts. Work in rnds in K4,P4 rib. Place a marker beg of rnd. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every  $2\frac{1}{2} - 2\frac{1}{2} - 2\frac{1}{2} - 2$  cm/1-1-1-0.8-0.8 in until there is altog. 76-76-80-84-84 sts on a rnd, and sleeve measures approx. 50-51-52-52-53 cm/19.7-20.1-20.5-20.5-20.9 in (or desired length). Bind off in rib.

Work same for the other sleeve.

# **Finishing**

Sew shoulder seams.

**Right front band:** Using needles size 7 mm, pick or knit up 132-140-140-148-148 sts (Note! Number of sts must be multiple with 8 sts). Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Bind off rather loosely. Work same for left front band.

Collar/neck band: Beg from right front. Pick or knit up approx. 58-58-62-62-62 sts (Note! Number of sts must be multiple with 4+2 sts). Work back and forth approx. 5 cm/2 in in K2,P2 rib. Inc 1 st in each knit- and purl-panel. Work in K3,P3 rib until collar measures approx. 10 cm/4 in. Inc again in the same way, and work in K4,P4 rib until collar measures approx. 15 cm/5.9 in. Bind off rather loosely in rib

Sew on sleeves (try not to stretch the sleeves when sewing). Weave in all ends on WS.

## **Body**

Using needles size7 mm and double yarn, cast on 140-152-164-176-184 sts. Work in rnds 5 cm/2 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 43-43-43-43-43 cm/16.9-16.9-16.9-16.9-16.9 in. Divide work at sides, 70-76-82-88-92 sts for both back and front.

# **Back**

Cont working back and forth in St st until work measures approx. 67-67-68-68-69 cm/26.4-26.4-26.8-26.8-27.2 in, and armhole measures approx. 24-24-25-25-26 cm/9.4-9.4-9.8-9.8-10.2 in. Bind off.

### **Front**

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 60-60-60-60-61 cm/23.6-23.6-23.6-23.6-24 in, bind of mid 12-12-14-14-14 sts. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 2x1 st. When front measures same as back, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

### **Sleeves**

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 28-28-32-32-32 sts. Work in rnds 5 cm/2 in in K2,P2 rib. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 36-36-40-40-42 sts. Cont working in rnds in St st. Place a marker beg of rnd, and inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 3-3-3-3 cm/1.2-1.2-1.2-1.2 in until there is altog. 66-66-70-70-72 sts on a rnd. When sleeve measures the given length, or as desired, bind off.

## **Finishing**

Join shoulder seams.

**Neck band:** Beg from one shoulder. Using circular needle size 6 mm, pick or knit up approx. 56-56-60-60-60 sts around neck edge. Work in rnds approx. 15 cm/5.9 in in K2,P2 rib. Bind off rather loosely in rib. Sew on sleeves.

2nd row (RS): K1 (= selvage st), knit yo and next st tog, \*1 yo, sl 1 st, knit yo and next st tog\*, rep \*-\* across the row, end with K1 (= selvage st).

**3<sup>rd</sup> row (WS):** K1 (=selvage st), 1 yo, sl 1 st, \*knit yo and next st tog, 1 yo, sl 1 st\*, rep \*-\* across the row, end with

K1 (= selvage st).

Rep 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows.

### **Back**

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 45-49-55-59-63 sts. Knit 1 row. Cont working in patent patt until work measures approx. 70-70-72-72-74 cm/27.6-27.6-28.3-28.3-29.1 in. Knit 1 row. Bind off.

### **Front**

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 38-38-39-39-41 cm/15-15-15.4-15.4-16.1 in, bind off mid st for V-neck. Finish each side separately. Bind off 1 st at neck edge every 3½ cm/1.4 in altog. 8 times. When front measures same as back, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

### **Sleeves**

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 25-25-27-27-29 sts. Work back and forth 3 cm/1.2 in in K1,P1 rib. Cont working back and forth in patent patt. Inc 1 st at each edge approx. every  $5 - 4\frac{1}{2} - 5 - 4\frac{1}{2} - 5 - 4\frac{1}{2} - 5 - 4\frac{1}{2} - 1.8 - 2 - 1.8 - 2$  in until there is altog. 43-45-45-47-47 sts. Inc sts are worked in patent patt. When sleeve measures the given length, or as desired, knit 1 row. Bind off.

# **Finishing**

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams, leaving approx. 10 cm/4 in splits each side, and approx. 24-25-25-26-26 cm/ in for armholes.

Sew sleeve seams.

**Neck band:** Beg from one shoulder, using needles size 6 mm, knit or pick up approx. 41-41-43-45 sts from both sides of the V-neck, and approx. 24 sts from back = approx. 106-106-110-110-114 sts. Place markers over both shoulders (around mid sts), and mid front. Cont working in rnds in K1,P1 rib. Dec 2 sts at each marker every 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd: Work until 2 sts rem before a marker – K2togtbl – K1 – K2tog2. Rep dec at each 3 markers every 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd until neck and measures approx. 3 cm/1.2 in. Bind off in rib.

Cont working back and forth in Garter st, and <u>inc 2 sts</u> inside first st (= selvage st) beg of each row (inc = knit same st twice, first tfl, then tbl, rep over 2sts).Rep inc until there is altog. 66 sts on a row. Work measures now approx. 15 cm/ 5.9 in.

Inc now for sleeves in the same way (2 sts beg of each row) until there is altog. 174 sts on a row. Cont working until work measures approx. 50 cm/19.7 in. Shape neck edge: K81, bind off next 12 sts. Finish each side separately (= 81 sts for each side). Bind off at neck edge every 2<sup>nd</sup> row 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1 st. When work measures approx. 57 cm/22.4 in, slip sts on holder, and work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

Slip all sts on same needle, and cast on 24 sts for neck edge = 174 sts on a row. Cont working in Garter st, and dec for sleeves and sides same as for front (dec at same height as you inc on front). Dec 2 sts beg of each row: K1 (= selvage st), K2tog 2 times. Bind off rem 30 sts.

### Finishing:

Sew sleeve seams (beg from first inc for sleeves on sides). **Edges for sleeves:** Using needles size 6 mm, pick or knit up approx. 32 sts. Cont working in rnds approx. 13 cm/5.1 in in K2,P2 rib. Bind off in rib. Work same for the other sleeve.

**Neck band:** Using needles size 6 mm, pick or knit up approx. 64 sts around neck edge. Work in rnds approx. 20 cm/9.8 in in K2,P2 rib. Bind off <u>rather loosely</u> in rib.

Using needles size 7mm and double yarn, cast on 42 sts. Work back and forth 3 cm/1.2 in K2,P2 rib. Make a buttonholes: work 4 sts – bind off next 2 sts – work 14 sts – bind off 2 sts – work 4 sts. Turn, and cast on 2 sts over the bound-off sts for each buttonhole. Cont working until work measures approx. 7 cm/2.8 in. Beg from RS, K2, P2 over 4 first and last sts, and St st over rem sts. When work measures approx. 63 cm/24.8 in, work K2,P2 rib over all sts. When work measures approx. 70 cm/27.6 in, bind off in rib. Sew on 4 buttons.

### Hat

Using needles size 6 mm and double yarn, cast on 72 sts. Work in rnds 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 20 cm/7.9 in. Beg dec for crown; \*K4, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Rep dec every rnd until 24 sts rem. Knit all sts tog in pairs. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, tighten the yarn, and weave in on WS.

Note! Use double yarn for cowl and hat – Kid Mohair + Nordlys.

## **Round cowl**

Using needles size 7 mm and double yarn, cast on 200 sts. Work in rnds approx. 16 cm/6.3 in in K2,P2 rib. Cast on rather loosely in rib.

### Hat

Using needles size 6 mm and double yarn, cast on 72 sts. Work in rnds 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working in rnds in St st until work

measures approx. 20 cm/7.9 in. Beg dec for crown: \*K4, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Rep dec every rnd until 24 sts rem. Knit all sts tog in pairs. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, tighten the yarn, and weave in on WS.

### Hat

Using needles size 6 mm, cast-on 60 sts. Work in rnds 5 cm/2 in in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 7 mm. Work in rnds in Garter st until work measures approx. 20 cm/7.9 in. Beg dec for crown: \*K4, K2tog\*, rep \*-\* across the rnd. Rep dec every rnd until 20 sts rem. Knit all sts tog in pairs. Break yarn, thread through rem sts, tighten the yarn, and weave in on WS.

### Scarf

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 30 sts. Work back and forth approx. 10 cm/4 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx.150 cm/59.1 in. Work 10 cm/4 in in rib. Bind off in rib.

+ 1 pair of clasps

**Gauge:** 14 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.** 

Note! Coat is worked in double yarn, Kid Mohair + Nordlys.

### Coat

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 132-140-156-172-180 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib, ending with K4. Cont working back and forth in St st. Place markers each side, 68-72-80-88-92 sts for back, and 32-34-38-42-44 sts for each front. When work measures 60-60-60-60-60-62 cm/23.6-23.6-23.6-23.6-24.4 in, beg V-neck dec. Dec 1 st at each edge inside 1 selvage st approx. every 2 cm/0.8 in. When work measures 66-66-67-67-69 cm/26-26-26.4-26.4-27.2 in, bind off 8 sts at each side (4 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and fronts separately.

### **Back**

Cont working in St st same as before. Bind off at armhole edges every  $2^{nd}$  row 2x2 sts and 1x1 st. Cont working until work measures approx. 90-90-92-92-95 cm/ in, and armhole measures 24-24-25-25-26 cm/9.4-9.4-9.8-9.8-10.2 in. Bind off.

### **Right front**

Work same as for back, and rep dec at V-neck edge altog. 13-13-13-14-14 times. When front measures same as back, bind off.

Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

### Sleeves

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32-32-40-40-40 sts. Work in rnds 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Place a marker beg of rnd = mid under sleeve. Cont working in rnds in St st. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every  $2\frac{1}{2} - 2\frac{1}{2} - 3-3-3$  cm/1-1-1.2-1.2-1.2 in until there is altog. 68-68-70-70-72 sts on a rnd. Work until sleeve measures 50-51-52-52-52 cm/19.7-20.1-20.5-20.5-20.5 in. Bind off mid under sleeve 8 sts (4 sts both sides of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every  $2^{nd}$  row 2x2 sts and 1x1 st. Bind off rem sts. Work same for the other sleeve.

### **Finishing**

Sew shoulder seams.

**Pockets:** Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 28 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Purl 1 row from WS, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 22 sts. Cont working back and forth in St st until pocket measures

approx. 20 cm/7.9 in. Bind off. Work same for the other pocket.

**Right front band:** Using needles size 7 mm, pick or knit up approx. 140-140-148-148-156 sts along right front edge, V-neck until mid back (Note! Number of sts must be multiple with 8 sts). Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Bind off rather loosely.

Work same for left front band.

Sew mid back seam.

Sew pockets approx. 2 cm/0.8 in inside front edge, and approx. 10 cm/4 in from lower edge.
