Circular needle and double pointed needles size 3 and 3½ mm – US 2 or 3 and 4 – UK/Canadian 11 and 10 or 9

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Body

Using needles size 3 mm and yellow yarn, cast on 140-160-180-200 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4-5-5-6 cm (1.6-2-2-2.4 in) in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. Cont working in St st and rep I as charted. When work measures 19-23-30-37 cm (7.5-9.1-11.8-14.6 in), place markers each side, 70-80-90-100 sts for both front and back. Cast on 3 sts with basic clr between markers. Purl new sts every row (= will be cut open later). Cont working in patt II (before starting patt II, end patt I as charted). When patt II is ready, cont working in stripes. When work measures approx. 30-34-42-50 cm (11.8-13.4-16.5-19.7 in), bind off 26-28-28-30 mid sts. Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st. When work measures 35-40-48-56 cm (13.8-15.7-18.9-22 in), bind off.

Sleeves

Using needles size 3 mm and yellow yarn, cast on 36-40-40-44 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4-5-5-6 cm (1.6-2-2-2.4 in) in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 51-55-57-63 sts. Place a marker beg of rnd (= mid under arm). Cont working in rnds, rep patt I as charted. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2-2-2-3 cm (0.8-0.8-0.8-1.2 in), until you have 73-79-83-87 sts on a rnd. When work measures the given length, turn work inside out. Using basic clr, work 5 rnds in St st. Bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

Finishing

Sew 4 dense machine seams along the p-sts for armholes. Cut open between the seams. Sew shoulder seams.

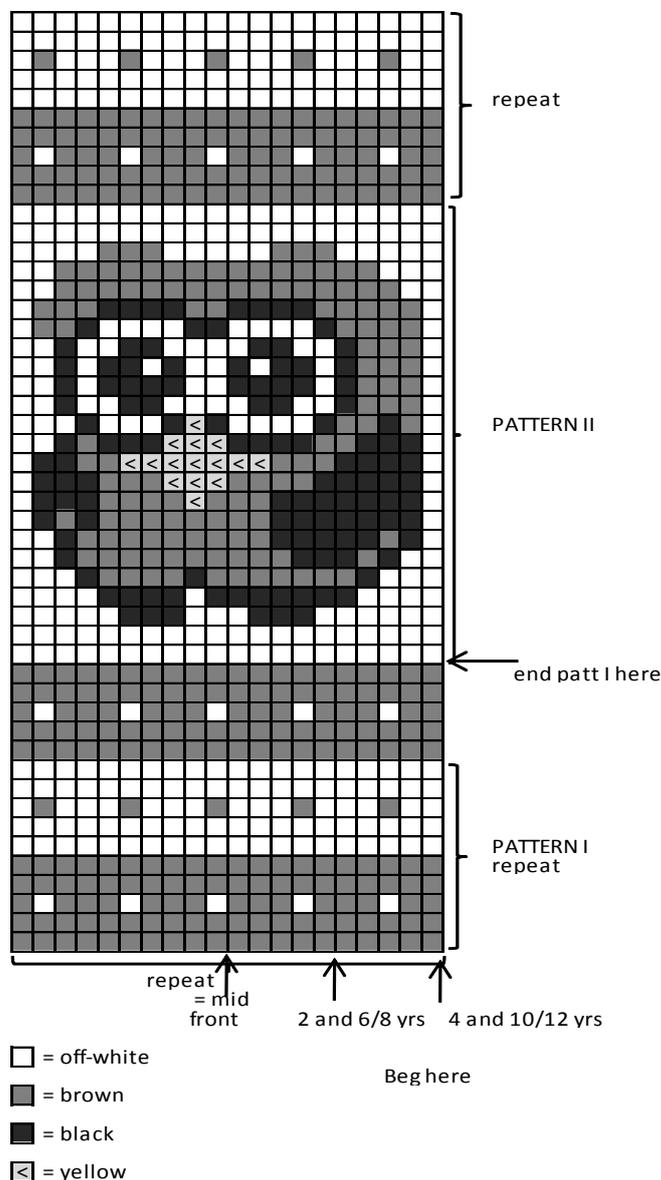
Neck band: Using needles size 3 mm and brown yarn, pick or knit up approx. 80-84-88-92 sts around neck edge. Work in rnds 2½ cm (1 in) in K1,P1 rib, P 1 rnd (= folding edge) + 2½ cm (1 in) in rib. Bind off rather loosely in rib. Fold neckband in double, and sew on WS.

Hood

Using needles size 3 mm and brown yarn, cast on 97-97-113-129 sts. Work back and forth 2½ cm (1 in) in K1,P1 rib, K 1 row (= WS = folding edge) + 2½ cm (1 in) rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. Cont working in St st. When work measures approx. 18-18-20-22 cm (7.1-7.1-7.9-8.7 in), measured from folding edge, bind off 23-23-27-27 mid sts. Work each side separately. Work 5-5-6-6 cm (2-2-2.4-2.4 in) in St st. Bind off. Work same for the other side. Sew mid back seam. Sew the bound-off sts to the top side pieces.

Sew on the sleeves, and sew the seam allowance over the cut edge. Weave in all ends on WS.

Sew on the hood, on the outer neck edge, starting mid back. Adjust over the back if needed. Don't attach the folding edge to the neck edge. Twist a cord using yellow yarn, and thread into front edge folder.

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 3 and 3½ mm – US 2 or 3 and 4 – UK/Canadian 11 and 10 or 9

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Seed st:

1st rnd: *K1, P1*

2nd rnd: K all p-sts, P all k-sts.

Rep 2nd rnd.

Body

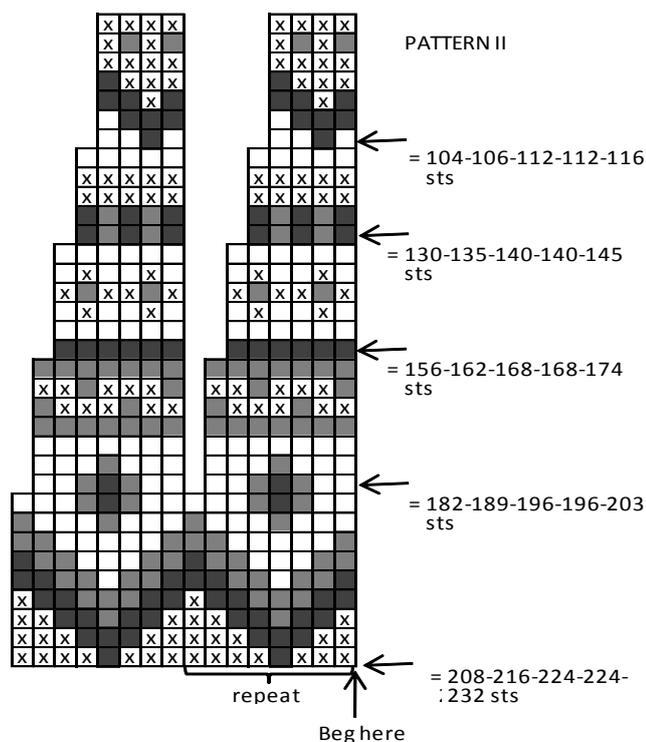
Using needles size 3 mm and heather clr yarn, cast on 152-160-176-184-192 sts. K 1 rnd in Seed st. Change to pink yarn, and work 2 rnds in Seed st. Cont working in Seed st with grey yarn until border measures approx. 4 cm (1.8 in). Change to needles size 3½ mm. Work in patt I as charted. When work measures 25-29-33-36-39 cm (9.8-11.4-13-14.2-15.4 in), place markers each side, 77-81-89-93-97 sts for back, and 75-79-87-91-95 sts for front. Bind off 10-10-12-12-12 sts each side (5-5-6-6-6 sts both sides of the markers). Put work aside, and knit the sleeves.

Sleeves

Using needles size 3 mm and heather clr yarn, cast on 36-36-40-40-44 sts. Work same for the border as in body piece. Change to needles size 3½ mm. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 49-51-53-57-63 sts. Place a marker beg of the rnd (= mid under arm). Cont working in rnds and rep patt I (check from mid st where to beg patt). Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2-2-2½-2-3½ cm (0.8-0.8-2-0.8-1.4 in) until you have altog. 69-73-77-83-87 sts on a rnd. When work measures the given length, or as desired, bind off 10-10-12-12-12 sts mid under arm (5-5-6-6-6 sts both sides of the markers). Slip rem sts on holder. Work same for the other sleeve.

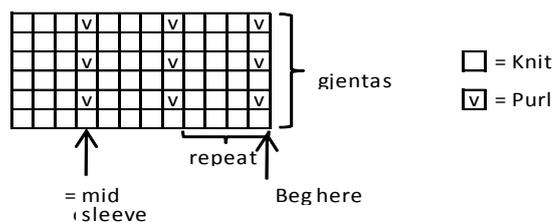
Yoke and raglan-dec: Slip all sts on same circular needle

= 250-266-282-302-318 sts. Place markers at all four seam lines (between body and sleeves). Cont working in rnds in patt I, and beg raglan-dec as foll: work until 3 sts rem before a marker, K2togtbl, K2, K2tog. Rep dec at each seam line every 2nd rnd altog. 4-6-7-8-10 times. After dec 218-218-226-238-238 sts rem on a rnd. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 208-216-224-224-232 sts. Cont working in rnds in patt II and dec as charted. When patt is ready, 104-108-112-112-116 sts rem on the rnd. Change to needles size 3 mm. Cont working in K1,P1 rib with grey yarn. When neck border measures approx. 2½ cm (1 in), change to pink yarn and work 2 rnds. Change to heather clr yarn, and work 1 rnd. Bind off in rib. Sew under arm seams. Weave in all ends on WS.

Hoodie:

Red, 650 7 8 8 9 10 11 12 balls
White, 600 1 1 1 2 2 2 2 balls

Double pointed needles and circular needle size 3 and 3 ½ mm – US 2 or 3 and 4 – UK/Canadian 11 and 10 or 9

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) in St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Pattern:

In rnds:

1st -3rd rnd: K3, P3, rep

4th-6th rnd: P3, K3, rep

Rep 1st – 6th rnd for desired length.

Back and forth:

1st and 3rd row: K3, P3, rep

2nd row: P3, K3, rep

4th and 6th row: P3, K3, rep

5th row: K3, P3, rep

Rep 1st – 6th row for desired length.

HOODIE

Using needles size 3½ mm and red yarn, cast on 148-160-172-180-192-200-208 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4-4-5-5-6-6-7 cm (1.6-1.6-2-2-2.4-2.4-2.8 in) in K2,P2 rib. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 144-160-176-176-192-208-208 sts. Change to needles size 3 ½ mm and white yarn. Work in patt I as charted, and adjust across the last rnd evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 150-162-174-180-192-198-204 sts. Change to

red yarn. Cont working in patt until work measures 21-24-28-32-35-33-40 cm (8.3-9.4-11-12.6-13.8-15.7 in). Place markers each side, 75-81-87-90-96-99-102 sts for front and back. Finish back and front separately.

Back: Cont working back and forth in patt. When armhole 15-16-17-18-18-20-22 cm (5.9-6.3-6.7-7.1-7.1-7.9-8.7 in), or work measures the given length, bind off.

Front: Work same as for back, **but** when armhole measures approx. 12-13-14-14-15-15-17 cm (4.7-5.1-5.5-5.5-5.9-5.9-6.7 in), bind off 23-27-27-29-29-31-31 mid sts for neck edge. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

Sleeves:

Using needles size 3 mm and red yarn, cast on 36-36-40-40-44-44-48 sts. Work rib same as for body. Change to needles size 3 ½ mm. K 1 rnd, inc evenly across the rnd 14-14-16-16-16-18-20 sts = 50-50-56-56-60-62-68 sts. Place a marker beg of the rnd (= mid under arm). Work in patt I as charted (check from mid st where to beg patt). Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2-2-2½-2½-2½-2½-2 cm (0.8-0.8-1-1-1-1-0.8 in) until you have altog. 70-74-78-82-88-92-102 sts on a rnd. Change to red yarn, and K 1 rnd. Cont working in patt, same as for body. When sleeve measures 28-31-34-38-42-45-47 cm (11-12.2-13.4-15-16.5-17.7-18.5 in) (or desired length), turn work inside out, and work 4 rnds in St st. Bind off.

Work same for the other sleeve.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

Neck band: Beg mid back. Using red yarn, pick or knit up 80-84-88-88-88-92-92 sts around neck edge. Work in rnds approx. 8 cm (3.1 in) K2,P2 rib. Bind off rather loosely. Break yarn, and weave in on WS. Fold neck and in double, and sew on WS.

Hood:

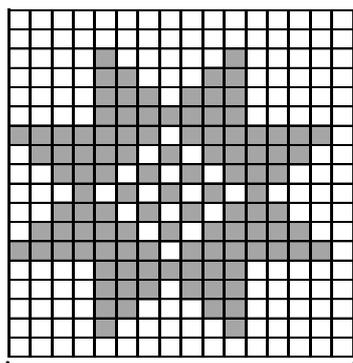
Using needles size 3 mm and red yarn, cast on 118-118-126-126-130-130-130 sts. Work back and forth approx. 4 cm (1.6 in) in K2,P2 rib. K 1 row (= WS = folding edge). Cont working in rib for 4 cm (1.6 in) more. Change to needles size 3 ½ mm, adjusting evenly across the row the number of sts to be 129 sts (same for all sizes). Work back and forth in patt I as charted. Bind off 1 st at each edge approx. every 2 cm (0.8 in) 4 times for 4 smallest sizes and 2 times for 3 largest sizes = 121-121-121-121-125-125 sts. Change to red yarn, K 1 row (= RS). Cont working back and forth in patt until work measures approx. 20-20-22-22-23-23-24 cm (7.9-7.9-8.7-8.7-9.1-9.1-9.4 in) (or desired length). Bind off 20 sts at each edge twice (same for all sizes). Bind off rem sts rather loosely.

Finishing, hood and sleeves:

Fold hood in double, and sew mid back seam along the bound-off sts. Sew hood along neck edge inside the neck band (adjust over mid back if needed). Fold front edge in double, and sew on WS. Weave in all ends on WS. Sew on sleeves and sew seam allowance over the seam. Twist a

cord (approx. 100-150 cm (39.4-59.1 in) using white yarn, and thread it into front edge folder. Make 2 pompons, approx. 4 cm (1.6 in) diameter, and fasten to each end of the cord.

HOODIE FOR DOGGIE

Using needles size 3 mm and red yarn, cast on 100 sts. Work in rnds 2 cm (0.8 in) in K2,P2 rib. K 1 rnd, inc evenly across the rnd 8 sts = 108 sts. Change to needles size 3 ½ mm. Place markers each side, 54 sts for both back and front. Work patt II as charted. Bind off on 1st rnd 8 mid back sts for split, and cast on 8 new sts on next rnd behind the bound-off sts. Change to red yarn, and K 1 rnd. Cont working in patt. When work measures approx. 10 cm (4 in), work back and front separately.

Back: Cont working back and forth in patt until armholes measure approx. 10 cm (4 in). Bind off.

Front: Work same as for back, **but** when work measures approx. 8 cm (3.1 in) bind off 20 mid sts for neck edge. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, 1nd 1x1st. Bind off when work measures same as back. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

Sleeves: Using needles size 3 mm and red yarn, cast on 36 sts. Work 6 rnds in K2,P2 rib. K 1 rnd. Change to needles size 3 ½ mm. Work approx. 4 cm (1.6 in) in patt. Bind off in p-sts.

Work same for the other sleeve.
 Sew shoulder seams.

Neck band:

Neck band needs to be open mid front for eventually threading in a cord. Beg mid front, using needles size 3 mm and red yarn, pick or knit up approx. 70 sts. Work back and forth approx. 5 cm (2 in) in K2,P2 rib. Bind off rather loosely. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Hood: Using needles size 3 mm and red yarn, cast on 78 sts. Work back and forth 2 cm (0.8 in) in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 3 ½ mm. Beg from RS. K 1 row,

inc evenly across the row 7 sts = 85 sts. Work patt 1 as charted (= 7 stars), **but** bind off on 2nd row 7 sts for both ears, between 2nd and 3rd star, and between 5th and 6th star. Cast on 7 new sts over the bound-off sts of both ears. Change to red yarn, and K 1 row (= RS). Cont working in patt. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 2x2, and 2x1 = 73 sts rem. When work measures approx. 17 cm (6.7 in), bind off sts on WS row. Sew mid back seam along the bound-off sts.

Sew on sleeves.

Crochet 1 rnd using white yarn sc around split and holes for ears.

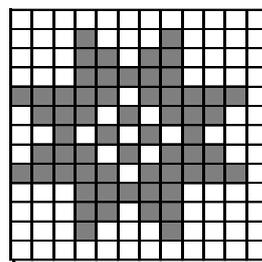
Sew on hood inside neck band, beg mid back.

Using white yarn, twist approx. 70 cm (27.6 in) long cord. Thread into neck band.

Make two pompons, diameter approx. 3 ½ cm (1.4 in), and fasten one to each end of the cord.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 3 ½ mm – US 4 – UK/Canadian 10 or 9

+ crochet hook 3 ½ mm (boy) – US C/2 or D/3 –

UK/Canadian 11

+ 2-2-3-3 buttons (boy)

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3 ½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SWEATER

Using needles size 3 ½ mm and blue (pink) yarn, cast on 154-166-178-194 sts. Work in rnds 4-4-5-5 cm (1.6-1.6-2-2 in) in Garter st. Place markers each side, 77-83-89-97 sts for both back and front. Work in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 27-29-35-41 cm (10.6-11.4-13.8-16.1 in). Bind off 12 sts each side for armholes (6 sts both sides of the markers). Put work aside, and knit the sleeves.

Sleeves

Using needles size 3 ½ mm and blue (pink) yarn, cast on 40-42-44-46 sts. Work in rnds approx. 3 cm (1.2 in) in Garter st. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 49-51-55-59 sts. Place a marker beg of rnd (= mid under arm). Cont working in St st. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 4-3 ½-3 ½-4 cm (1.6-1.4-1.4-1.6 in) until you have altog. 61-67-73-79 sts on a rnd. When work measures approx. 30-34-38-44 cm (11.8-13.4-15-17.3 in) (or desired length), bind off 12 sts mid under arm (6 sts oth sides of the marker). Put work aside, and knit same for the other sleeve.

Yoke

Slip all sts on same circular needle size 3 ½ mm, with sleeves over bound-off sts for armholes (= 228-252-276-304 sts). Place markers at each 4 seam lines. Cont working in rnds in patt as charted (beg as charted for front and back, and check from mid st where to beg patt). Beg raglan-dec: Dec every 2nd rnd at each seam line as foll: Work until 3 sts rem before seam line, K2togtbl, K2, K2tog (all raglan-

dec sts are worked in blue (pink) yarn). Rep dec altog. 14-17-19-21 times (when patt is ready, cont working in blue (pink) yarn). Next rnd: Bind off 15-15-17-21 mid sts for front neck edge. Cont working back and forth (cont raglan-dec). Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st. When you have altog. 19-22-24-26 raglan-dec, pick or knit up sts from the bound-off sts for neck edge (= approx. 76-76-84-96 sts on a rnd).

Neck band (girl): Work in rnds approx 3 cm (1.2 in) in Garter st. Bind off rather loosely.

Neck collar (boy): Work in rnds approx. 6-8-10-12 cm (2.4-3.1-4-4.7 in) in K2,P2 rib. Divide work on right shoulder, and cont working back and forth. When collar measures approx, 10-14-18-22 cm (4-5.5-7.1-8.7 in) (or desired length), work 1 row in light blue, and then 1 row in marine blue. Bind off rather loosely in rib.

Using crochet hook size 3 ½ mm and blue yarn, make 2-2-3-3 button hole loops on right edge of the split: ch4, skip 2 st, fasten with 1 sl st, turn, and work 8 sc into the loop, end with 1 sl st. Place one loop approx. 1 cm (0.4 in) from upper edge, one approx. 1 cm (0.4 in) from beg of split, and one between them.

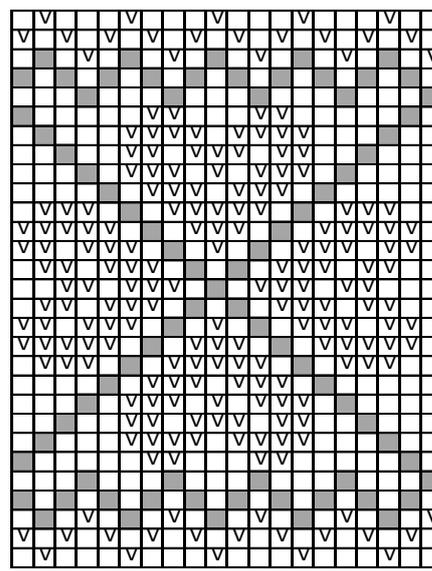
Sew on buttons on left edge.

Finishing

Sew mid under arm seams.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

TUNIC

Using needles size 3½ mm and light grey yarn, cast on 150-176-196 sts. Work in rnds 3 cm (1.2 in) in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in St st. Inc evenly across 1st rnd 10-12-16 sts = 160-188-212 sts. Place markers each side, 80-94-106 sts for both front and back. When work measures approx. 23-31-49 cm (9.1-12.2-19.3 in) (or desired length for skirt), work for front as foll: K20-23-25, slip 5-6-8 sts on cn, and hold to front, K 1st from cn tog with 1 st on needle, Ktog rem sts from cn in the same way, K20-24-24, slip 5-6-8 sts on cn, and hold to back, K 1 st from needle tog with 1 st from cn, Ktog rem sts from cn in the same way, K rem sts. K 1 rnd with light grey yarn, dec evenly across the rnd 48-44-52 sts = 112-144-160 sts. Place new markers each side, 55-71-79 sts for back, and 57-73-81 sts for front. Cont working in patt I, beg as charted. When patt is ready, cont working in light grey yarn. When work measures approx. 33-41-59 cm (13-16.1-23.2 in), bind off each side 4 sts (2 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and front separately.

Back:

Cont working back and forth in St st. When work armhole measures approx. 15-17-19 cm (5.9-6.7-7.5 in), bind off.

Front:

Work same as for back. When armhole measures approx. 12-13-14 cm (4.7-5.1-5.5 in), bind off 19-21-25 mid sts for neck edge. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st (same for all sizes). When work measures same as back, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

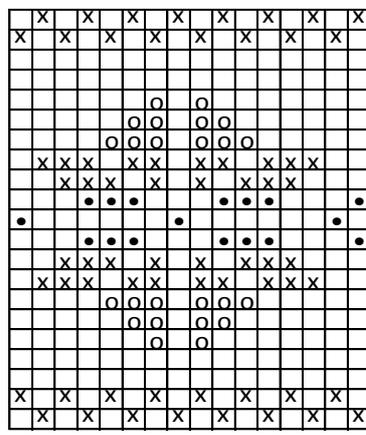
Neck and:

Using needles size 3 mm, pick or knit up approx. 76-80-84 sts around neck edge. Work in rnds 3 cm (1.2 in) in K2,P2 rib. K 1 rnd (= folding edge). Cont working in rnds 3 cm (1.2 in) rib. Bind off rather loosely. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Armhole band:

Using needles size 3 mm, pick or knit up 72-80-88 sts. Work 3 cm (1.2 in) in K2,P2 rib. Bind off in rib.

Body

Using needles size 3 mm and violet yarn, cast on 145-169-181-193 sts. Work back and forth approx. 3-3-4-4 cm (1.2-1.2-1.6-1.6 in) in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. Cont working back and forth in St st. When work measures 13-17-21-26 cm (5.1-6.7-8.3-10.2 in), place markers each side, 73-89-95-101 sts for back, and 36-40-43-46 sts for each front. Cont working in patt I. When work measures 24-28-32-37 cm (9.4-11-12.6-14.6 in), work back and front separately.

Back

Cont working in patt I. When patt is ready, cont working in St st until work measures 40-45-50-56 cm (15.7-17.7-19.7-22 in), and armhole measures approx. 16-17-18-19 cm (6.3-6.7-7.1-7.5 in). Slip sts on holder, or bind off.

Right front

Work same as for back. After patt I cont with patt II for right front. When patt II is ready, cont working in St st until work measures approx. 35-40-44-50 cm (13.8-15.7-17.3-19.7 in). Bind off 5-6-7-8 sts at neck edge. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st. When work measures same as back, slip sts on holder, or bind off.

Left front

Work same as right front, but in reverse. After patt I cont with patt II for left front. Check where to beg patt (beg patt inside 1st from front edge).

Sleeves

Using needles size 3 mm and violet yarn, cast on 36-40-40-44 sts. Work in rnds 4-4-5-5 cm (1.6-1.6-2-2 in) in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 51-53-57-63 sts. Place a marker mid under arm. Cont working in rnds in St st. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2-2½-2½-3 cm (0.8-1-1-1.2 in) until work measures 12-15-19-24 cm (4.7-5.9-7.5-9.4 in) and you have 73-77-83-87 sts on a rnd. Work patt I as charted. When patt is ready, work in St st with violet yarn until work measures the given length, or as desired. Bind off.

Finishing

Join shoulder seams

Neck band: Using needles size 3 mm and violet yarn, pick or knit up approx. 83-87-91-95 sts around neck edge. Work back and forth 3 cm (1.2 in) in K1,P1 rib. Bind off in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Left front edge: Using needles size 3 mm and violet yarn, pick or knit up approx. 85-95-105-117 sts along left front edge. Work 4 rows in St st. Bind off in k-sts (= WS row). Using needles size 3 mm, pick up from WS approx. 75-83-93-101 sts. Work 4 rows in St st. Bind off.

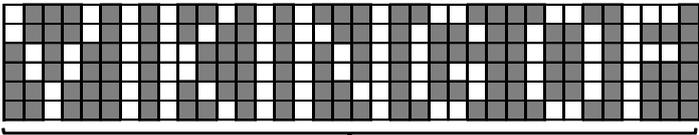

Hood

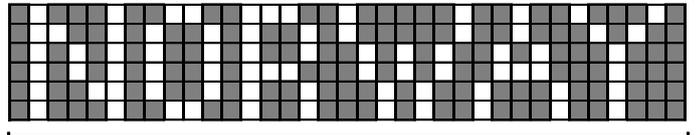

Finish each side separately. Work 5-6-6-6 cm (2-2.4-2.4-2.4 in) in St st. Bind off. Work same for the other side. Sew mid back seam. Sew the bound-off mid sts to side pieces. Fold front edge in double, and sew on WS (leave short edges on both sides open for threading in a cord later on).

Sew zipper between front edges. Sew on sleeves. Weave in all ends on WS.

Sew hood inside the neck band, beg from mid back (adjust over mid back if needed). Twist a cord and thread it into front edge folder of the hood



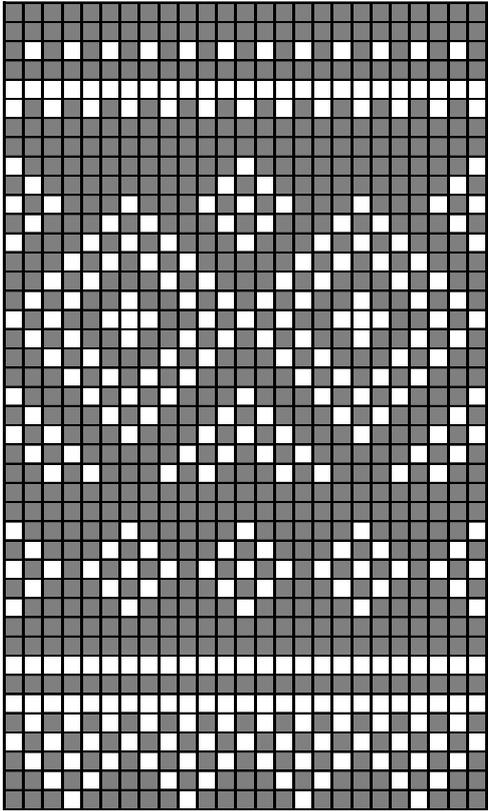

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

SWEATER

Using needles size 3 mm and light blue yarn, cast on 68-196 sts. Work in rnds 4 cm (1.6 in) in K2,P2 rib. Place markers each side, 85-99 sts for front, and 83-97 sts for back. Change to needles size 3½ mm and grey yarn. Cont working in St st. When work measures 26-31 cm (10.2-12.2 in), work in patt I as charted (twist basic clr and patt clr yarns on WS when needed). **Note!** Bind off 10 sts each side for armholes on 12th patt rnd (5 sts both sides of the markers). Put work aside, and knit the sleeves.

Sleeves

Using needles size 3 mm and light blue yarn, cast on 40-44 m sts. Work in rnds 4 cm (1.6 in) in K2,P2 rib. K 1 rnd, and inc evenly across the rnd 9-9 sts = 49-53 sts. Place a marker mid under sleeve. Change to needles size 3½ mm and grey yarn. Cont working in St st. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2-2½ cm (0.8-1 in) until you have 81-89 sts, **but** when work measures approx. 4 cm (1.6 in) less than the given length (or desired length), work in patt I (check from mid where to beg patt). Bind off on 12th patt rnd 5 sts both sides of the marker (same as for body). Put work aside and knit the other sleeve.

Yoke

Slip all sts on same long circular needle with sleeves over the bound-off sts for armholes = 290-334 sts. Place markers at each 4 seam lines. Cont working in patt I (rep altog twice), then patt II and patt III as charted. **Same time**, beg raglan-dec at each 4 seam lines (Note! Raglan-dec sts are worked in basic clr) as foll: Work until 3 sts rem before 1st marker, K2tog, K2, K2togtbl, rep dec at all 4 seam lines every 2nd rnd 24-27 times (approx. 15-17 cm (5.9-6.7 in)). Next rnd: Bind off 9-13 mid front sts for neck edge. Cont working back and forth in patt and raglan-dec. Bind off at

each edge every 2nd row 2-3 times 2 sts. When you have altog. 27-30 raglan-dec, pick up approx. 20-26 sts along neck edge = 92-100 sts. Change to needles size 3 mm. Using light blue yarn, work in rnds 4 cm (1.6 in) in K2,P2 rib. P 1 rnd (= folding edge). Change to grey yarn, and work 4 cm (1.6 in) in rib. Bind off in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Finishing:

Sew under arm seams.

Weave in all ends on WS.

HAT

Two alternatives for hat, either with round top with 1 pompon on top, or flat model with 1 pompon in each top corner.

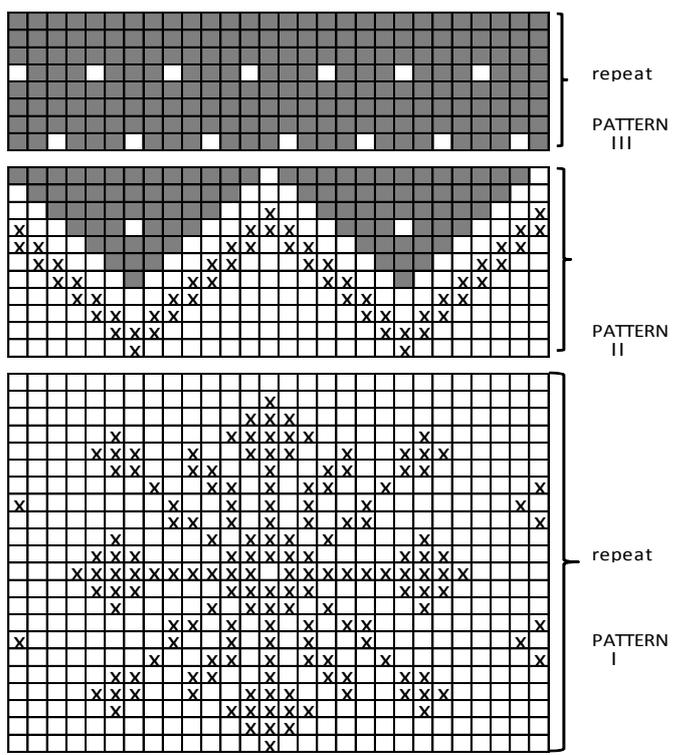
Both models: Using needles size 3 mm and light blue yarn, cast on 100-108 sts. Work in rnds 4 cm (1.6 in) in K2,P2 rib. K 1 rnd, inc evenly across the rnd 10-2 sts = 110-110 sts. Change to needles size 3½ mm. Work in patt IV, and then in patt V. Cont working in St st with grey yarn until work measures 16-17 cm (6.3-6.7 in) for round top, and approx. 23-25 cm (9.1-9.8 in) for flat top.

Round top: *K9, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Work 1 rnd without dec. *K8, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Work 1 rnd without dec. Rep dec every 2nd rnd, with 1 st less between dec until 10 sts rem. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts. Pull tightly, and weave in ends on WS. Using light blue yarn, make a pompon (diameter approx. 7 cm (2.8 in), and fasten on top.

Flat top: Bind off all sts rather loosely. Sew top seam. Using light blue yarn, make 2 pompons (diameter approx. 6 cm (2.4 in), and fasten one to each top corner.

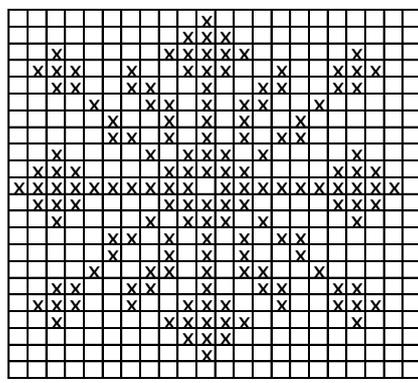

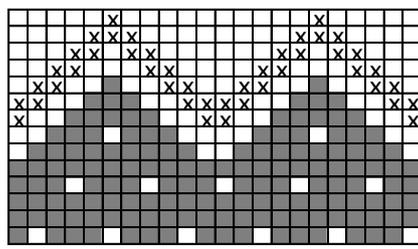

K 1 rnd, and place markers each side, 74-80-86-90-96-100 sts for both front and back. Cont working in rnds in St st and patt as charted: Beg from side marker, 11-14-17-19-22-24 sts in St st, *P2, patt over 16 sts*, rep *.* altog. 3 times, end with P2. Work rem 11-14-17-

19-22-24 sts in St st (= front). Work same for back. When work measures approx. 21-24-28-32-35-38 cm (8.3-9.4-11-12.6-13.8-15 in), Bind off each side 8-8-10-10-12-12 sts (4-4-5-5-6-6 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and front separately.

Back: Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x2 and 1x1 st. When work measures 36-40-45-50-54-58 cm (14.2-15.7-17.7-19.7-21.3-22.8 in), and armhole measures approx. 15-16-17-18-19 cm (5.9-6.3-6.7-7.1-7.5 in), bind off.

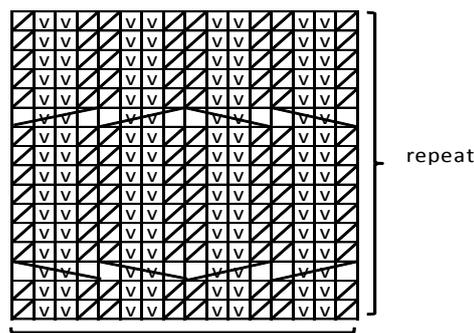

Place a marker mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 3-3-3½-4-3½-3½ cm (1.2-1.2-1.4-1.6-1.4-1.4 in) until you have 70-74-78-82-88-92 sts on a rnd. When work measures the given length, or as desired, bind off mid under arm 8-8-10-10-12-12 sts (4-4-5-5-6-6 sts both sides of the marker). Cont working back and forth, and bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x2 and 1x1st. Bind off rem sts. Work same for the other sleeve.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

Neck band: Using a short circular needle, pick or knit up approx. 74-78-82-88-92-98 sts around neck edge. Work 3 cm (1.2 in) in rib. P 1 rnd (= folding edge) + 3 cm (1.2 in) in rib. Bind off rather loosely. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS. Sew on sleeves. Weave in all ends on WS.

When work measures approx. 21-24-28-32-35-38 cm (8.3-9.4-11-12.6-13.8-15 in), bind off each side 8-8-10-10-12-12 sts (4-4-5-5-6-6 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and front separately.

Back: Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x2 and 1x1st. When work measures 36-40-45-50-54-58 cm (14.2-15.7-17.7-19.7-21.3-22.8 in), and armhole measures approx. 15-16-17-18-19 cm (5.9-6.3-6.7-7.1-7.5 in), bind off.

Front: Work same as for back. When work measures 31-35-40-44-48-52 cm (12.2-13.8-15.7-17.3-18.9-20.5 in), bind off 15-17-17-19-19-21 mid sts for neck edge. Work each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2 and 2-2-2-3-3-3x1 st. When work measures same as back, bind off.

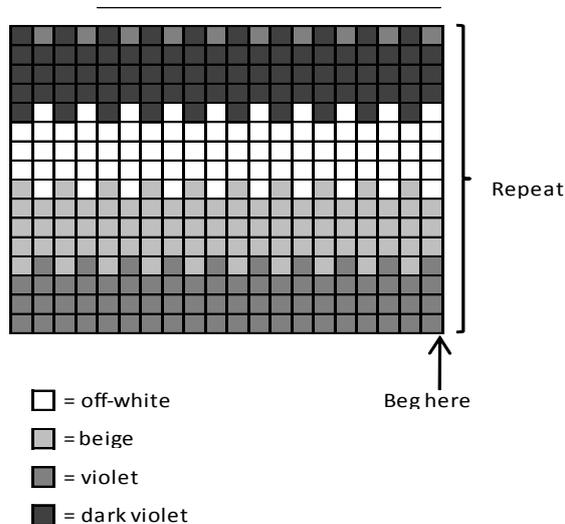

Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 3-3-3½-4-3½-3 cm (1.2-1.2-1.4-1.6-1.4-1.2 in) until you have 71-75-79-83-89-93 sts on a rnd. When work measures the given length, or as desired, bind off 8-8-10-10-12-12 sts mid under arm (4-4-5-5-6-6 sts both sides of the marker). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x2 and 1x1 st. Bind off rem sts. Work same for the other sleeve.

Finishing: Sew shoulder seams.

Neck band: Using a short circular needle size 3 mm and dark violet yarn, pick or knit up approx. 74-78-82-88-92-98 sts. Work 3 cm (1.2 in) in K1,P1 rib. P 1 rnd (= folding edge) + 3 cm (in) rib. Bind off rather loosely. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS. Sew on sleeves. Weave in all ends on WS.

HAT (size: 2/4 – 6/8 – 10/12 yrs)

Using needles size 3 mm and dark violet yarn, cast on 100-106-110 sts. Work 4 rnds in K1,P1 rib. Cont working in rnds in patt as charted. When work measures 13-15-16 cm (5.1-5.9-6.3 in), measured from cast-on edge, P 1 rnd (= edge for crochet later on). Cont working in St st and stripe patt. Work 2 rnds, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 90-100-100 sts. Work 2 rnds. Beg dec as foll: *K16-18-18, K2togtbl, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Rep dec every 2nd rnd, with 2 sts less between dec until 20-20-20 sts rem on a rnd. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs = 10-10-10 sts rem. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts, pull tightly. Weave in all ends on WS. Using crochet hook size 3 mm and heather clr yarn, crochet 1 rnd sc to p-rnd, approx. 1 sc to each st (number of sts must be multiple by 6). Next rnd: Ch1, *skip 2 sts, 2 dc + ch1 + 2 dc to same st, 1 sc to next st*, rep *-* across the rnd. Weave in all ends on WS.

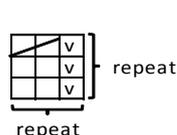

Dec in every 2nd report as foll: K2tog, K1, P1, K2 (= 2 reports), rep across the rnd = 110 sts. Work 2 rnds without dec (= K2, P1, K2, rep across the rnd, cont working mini cables). Next rnd: Dec rem p-sts (dark violet sts) = K1, K2tog, K2, rep across the rnd = 88 sts. Next rnd: Dec as foll: K2, K2tog, rep across the rnd = 66 sts. Work 2 rnds without dec. Next rnd: K1, K2tog, rep across the rnd = 44 sts. Work 1 rnd without dec. Next rnd: K all sts tog in pairs. Next rnd: Rep dec = 11 sts. Break yarn, thread through rem sts. Weave in ends on WS. Using both light and dark violet yarn, twist a cord. Make tassels with light and dark violet yarn by winding the yarn several times around fingers. Tie a knot at one end, and cut open from the other end. Fasten the tassels to the cord. Fasten the cord on top of the hat. Weave in all ends on WS.

MITTENS

Using needles size 3½ mm and light violet yarn, cast on 54 sts. Work in rnds in patt I. When work measures approx. 7 cm (in), K 1 rnd in light violet yarn, dec 2 sts at each side = 50 sts. Place markers each side, 25 sts for both sides. Cont working in St st with light violet yarn, but use 2 small balls of dark violet yarn, and work patt II as charted, once at each side.

Thumb: When work measures approx. 13 cm (5.1 in) (measured from cast-on edge), slip first 8 sts on holder. Cast on 8 new sts, and cont working in rnds in stripe patt on sides until work measures approx. 20 cm (7.9 in) (or 3 cm (1.2 in) before starting dec). Dec as foll: K2togtl before dark violet st on the side, and K2tog after the other dark violet st on the side (= 3 sts in between), rep dec at the other side. Rep dec every rnd until 8 sts rem. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts, pull tightly, and weave in on WS. **Thumb:** in light violet; sl 8 sts from holder on needles size 3½ mm. Pick up 8 sts from cast-on sts + 1 st each side = 18 sts. Divide sts on 3 dpn. Work in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 5 cm (2 in), or desired length. Beg dec: K all sts tog in pairs. Work 1 rnd without dec. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts, pull tightly and weave in owns.

Twist a cord using light and dark violet yarn. Thread cord to cable patt, and tie a bow (see photo).

Work same for the other mitten, but in reverse.

Weave in all ends on WS.

Beg necklet from upper edge.

Using needles size 3½ mm and light violet yarn, cast on 130 sts. Work back and forth as foll: 8 sts in Garter st, patt I as charted over 115 sts, 8 sts in Garter st (first and last 8 sts = front edges). Cont working back and forth as established until work measures approx. 10 cm (4 in). Make buttonhole when work measures 1 cm (in) and then approx. every 4 cm (in): RS row: K3, bind off 2 sts, (next row: cast on 2 new sts over the bound-off sts), K3.

Cont working in St st. Inc evenly across 1st row 47 sts = 177 sts. Work 3 cm (in), inc on RS row as foll: 8 sts in Garter st, *K7, M1*, rep *-* across the row, end with K7, 8 sts in Garter sts. Rep inc approx every 3 cm (in) altog. 7 times = 331 sts, and work measures approx. 31 cm (in), measured from cast-on edge. Work 6 rows in Garter st over all sts. Bind off on WS. Weave in all ends on WS. Sew on buttons.

Circular needle and double pointed needles size 3 and 3½ mm – US 2 or 3 and 4 – UK/Canadian 11 and 10 or 9 + zipper (take the measurement from ready garment).

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Body

Using needles size 3 mm and blue or pink yarn, cast on 145-161-177-185-193 sts. Work back and forth approx. 8-8-10-10-12 cm (3.1-3.1-4-4-4.7-4.7 in) in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. Cont working in rnds in St st and patt I as charted, **but** cast on 3 sts mid front. Purl mid front sts each rnd, using basic clr (= will be eventually cut open from the front). When work measures 23-27-30-33-36 cm (9.1-10.6-11.8-13-14.2 in), place markers each side, 77-85-93-97-101 sts for back, and 34-38-42-44-46 sts for each front. Using basic clr, cast on 3 new sts between sidemarkers (will be cut open for armholes). Purl these new sts in basic clr. Cont working in patt until work measures approx. 33-38-42-45-49 cm. Bind off 25-27-27-29-31 mid sts (incl 3 mid sts). Cont working back and forth. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st. When work measures 38-43-47-51-55 cm (15-16.9-18.5-20.1-21.7 in), bind off.

Sleeves

Using needles size 3 mm and blue or pink yarn, cast on 36-36-40-40-44 sts. Work in rnds 5-5-6-6-7 cm (2-2-2.4-2.4-2.8 in) in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. K 1 rnd, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 49-51-53-57-63 sts. Place a marker mid under sleeve. Incl 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 2½- 2½-2½-2½-3 cm (1-1-1-1-1.2 in) until you have altog. 69-73-77-83-87 sts on a rnd. When work measures the given length, or as desired, turn work inside out. Work 5 rnds in St st with basic clr. Bind off rather loosely.

Finishing

Sew 4 machine seams along the p-sts mid front and armholes (= approx. 15-16-17-18-19 cm (5.9-6.3-6.7-7.1-7.5 in). Check the measurement from sleeves. Cut open between the seams. Sew shoulder seams.

Neck band: Using needles size 3 mm and blue or pink yarn, pick or knit up approx. 81-87-93-97-101 sts around neck edge. Work

back and forth 5 cm (2 in) in K1,P1 rib. Bind off rather loosely in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS.

Left front edge band: Using needles size 3 mm and blue or pink yarn, pick or knit up approx. 87-97-107-117-125 sts, and work 6 rows in St st. Bind off rather loosely on WS row in k-sts. Using needles size 3 mm, pick or knit up approx. 87-97-107-117-125 sts from WS. Work 5 rows in St st. Bind off.

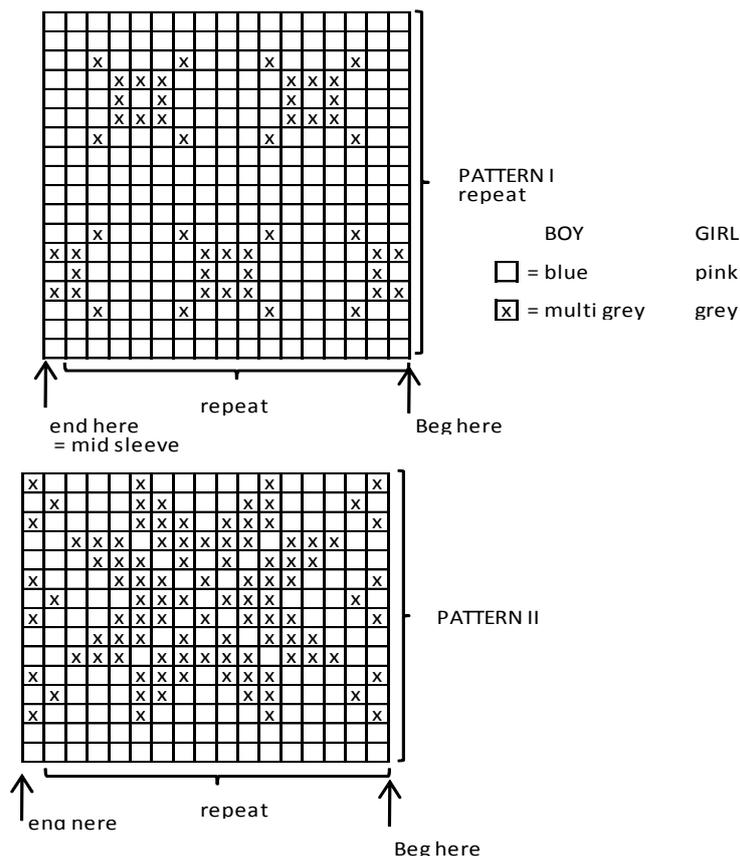
Right front edge band: Work same as for left front edge.

HOOD

Using needles size 3 mm and blue or pink clr yarn, cast on 97-97-113-113-129 sts. Work back and forth 2½ cm (1 in) in K1, P1 rib. K 1 rnd (= WS = folding edge) + 2½ cm (1 in) in rib. Change to needles size 3½ mm. Cont working in St st and patt II as charted. Cont working in St st without patt until work measures approx. 18-18-20-20-22 cm (7.1-7.1-7.9-7.9-8.7 in), measured from folding edge. Bind off 23-23-27-27-27 mid sts. Work each side separately. Work 5-5-6-6-6 cm (2-2-2.4-2.4-2.4 in) in St st. Bind off. Work same for the other side. Sew mid back seam. Sew top seam (= sew bound-off sts to side sts on top). Fold front rib in double, and sew on WS. Don't sew the short edges of the folding edge as eventually you need to thread in a cord.

Sew on zipper between the front edge bands. Sew on sleeves, and sew seam allowance over the cut edge on WS. Weave in all loose ends.

Sew hood along neck edge, with neck band inside. Beg mid back (adjust over mid back if needed). Don't sew the front edge folding to neck edge! Twist a cord, and thread into front edge folder.

Gauge: 23 sts = approx. 10 cm (4 in) over St st using needles size 3½ mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

DRESS

Using circular needle size 3½ mm and grey yarn, cast on 198-210-224-236-250 sts. Work in rnds 3 cm (1.2 in) in St st. Eyelet rnd: *K2tog, 1 yo*, rep *-* across the rnd = folding edge. Place markers each side, 99-105-113-119-125 sts for back, and 99-105-111-117-125 sts for front. Beg from front, and work as foll: 25-28-32-35-38sts in St

st, cable patt over 49 sts, 25-28-32-35-38 sts in St st. Work same for back, but 25-28-31-34-38 sts in St st at each side. Cont working in rnds as established. When work measures approx. 33-35-38-41-44 cm (13-13.8-15-16.1-17.3 in), K 1 rnd in St st over all sts, adjusting evenly across the rnd the number of sts to be 132-138-150-156-168 sts. Place new markers each side, 67-69-75-79-85 sts for front, and 65-69-75-77-83 sts for back. Work patt I as charted. When patt is ready, bind off 8 sts each side (4 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and front separately.

Back

Cont working back and forth in St st. Bind off at each edge every 2nd row 1x2 and 1x1 st (same for all sizes). When work measures 51-54-58-62-66 cm (20.1-21.3-22.8-24.4-26 in), and armhole measures approx. 13-14-15-16-17 cm (5.1-5.5-5.9-6.3-6.7 in), bind off.

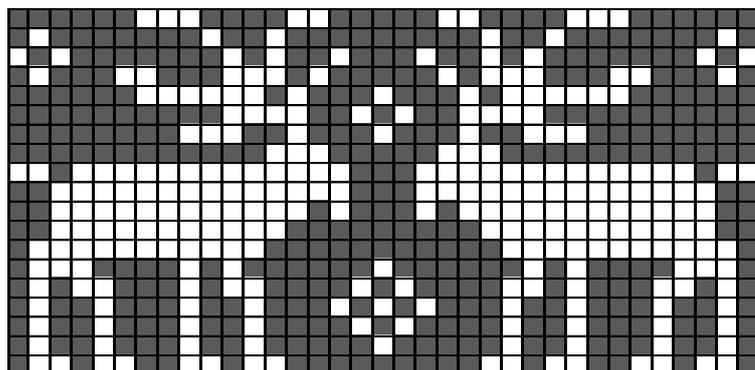
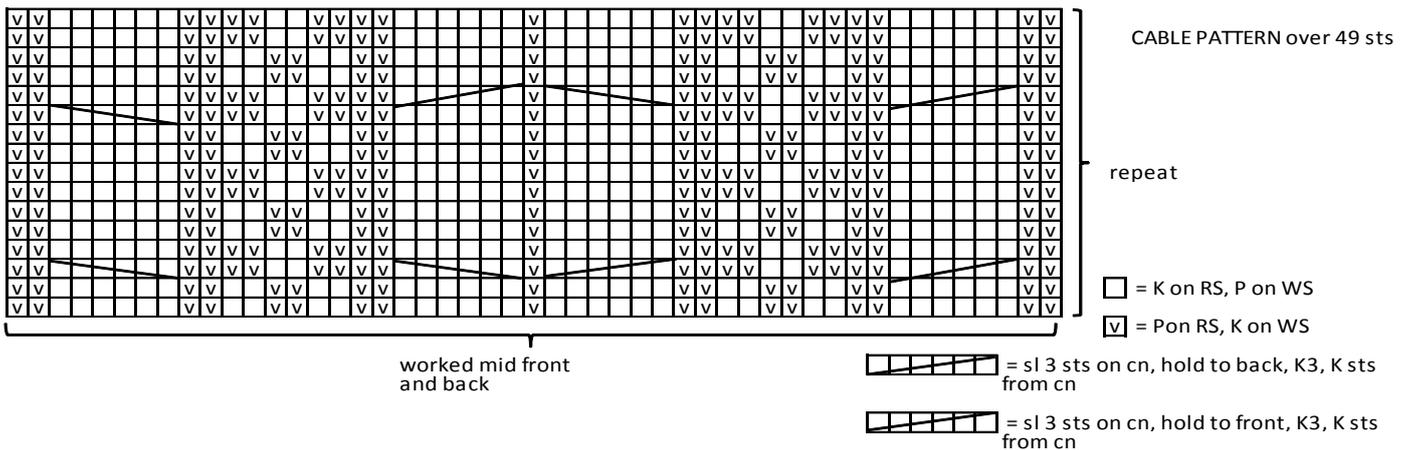
Front

Work same as for back. After finishing armhole dec, work patt II mid front: Beg with RS row: 9-10-13-15-18 sts in grey, patt over 35 sts, 9-10-13-15-18 sts in grey. When patt II is ready, cont working in St st with grey yarn until armhole measures approx. 9-10-11-11-12 cm (3.5-4-4.3-4.3-4.7 in). Bind off 17-19-19-21-21 mid sts. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 1x3, 1x2, and 1x1 st. When work measures same as back, bind off. Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

Finishing

Sew shoulder seams

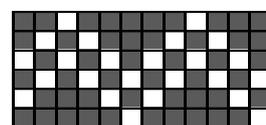
Neck band: Using crochet hook size 3 mm and grey yarn, crochet 1 rnd sc (approx. 1 sc to each st, skip every 4th st). Next rnd: Change to off-white yarn. Work picot edge: *Ch3, 1 sc to first ch-st, skip 1 st, 1 sc to next st*, rep*-* across the rnd. Work same for armholes
