Violet, 367 4 5 6 balls

Circular needle 80 cm/31.5 in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 50 – 56 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 46 – 56 – 61 cm/18.1-22-24 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 36 – 46 – 50 cm/14.2-18.1-19.7 in, bind off for neck edge 10 – 10 – 12 mid sts. Finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 3x1 st. When work measures approx. 41 – 51 – 55 cm/16.1-20.1-21.7 in, bind off.

Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32 – 36 – 38 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, and inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 5 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-2.2 in, until you have 42 – 48 – 52 sts on a row and sleeve measures 31 – 36 – 42 cm/12.2-14.2-16.5 in. Bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 5-6-7 cm/2-2.4-2.8 in on both sides, and for armholes approx. 18 – 20 – 22 cm/7.1-7.9-8.7 in. Sew sleeve seams. sew on sleeves.

Light Grey, 313 8 8 9 ball

Circular needle 80 cm/31.5 in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 66 – 72 – 78 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 68 – 71 – 74 cm/26.8-28-29.1 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 56 – 59 – 62 cm/22-23.2-24.4 in, bind off for neck edge 12 – 14 – 14 mid sts, and finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 4x1 st. When work measures approx. 62 – 65 – 68 cm/24.4-25.6-26.8 in, bind off.

Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 46 – 48 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, and inc 1 st approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 4 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-1.8 in until you have 60 – 62 – 68 sts on a row, and sleeve measures 46 – 48 – 48 cm/18.1-18.9-18.9 in. Bind off.

Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-3.1-3.1 in on both sides, and armholes approx. 25 – 26 – 28 cm/9.8-10.2-11 in. Sew sleeve seams. Sew on sleeves.

Circular needle 80 cm/ in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32 – 36 – 38 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st each side approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 5 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-2.2 in until you have 42 – 48 – 52 sts on a row, and sleeve measures 31 – 36 – 42 cm/12.2-14.2-16.5 in. Bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 5 – 6 – 7 cm/2-2.4-2.8 in on both sides, and for armholes approx. 18 – 20 – 22 cm/7.1-7.9-8.7 in.

HOOD

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 62 – 66 – 70 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 24 – 26 – 28 cm/9.4-10.2-11 in. Bind off 14 mid sts, and finish each side separately. Work 5 cm/2 in both sides of the bound-off sts. Join mid back seam (sts on both sides of the bound-off sts). Sew top seam.

Sew hood along neck edge.

POCKETS

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 14 – 16 – 18 sts. Work 15 – 16 – 18 cm/5.9-6.3-7.1 in in Garter st. Bind off.

Sew on pockets, approx. 2 cm/0.8 in from rib, and approx. 5 – 5 – 6 cm/2-2-2.4 in from side seam.

Sew sleeve seams. Sew on sleeves.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 46 – 48 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 4 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-1.8 in until you have 60 – 62 – 68 sts on a row, and sleeve measures 46 – 48 – 48 cm/18.1-18.9-18.9 in. Bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew side seams, leave splits, approx. 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-3.1-3.1 in on both sides, and for armholes approx. 25 – 26 – 28 cm/9.8-10.2-11 in.

HOOD

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 70 – 74 – 78 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 28 – 30 – 32 cm/ 11-11.8-12.6 in. Bind off 16 mid sts, and finish each side separately. Work 6 cm/2.4 in both sides of the bound-off sts. Join mid back seam (= sts on both sides of the bound-off sts). Sew top seam.

Sew hood along neck edge.

POCKETS

Cast on 20 sts, and work 20 cm/7.9 in in Garter st. Bind off.

Work same for the other pocket.

Sew on pockets approx. 2 cm/0.8 in from rib, and approx. 5 – 6 – 8 cm/2-2.4-3.1 in from side seam.

Sew sleeve seams. Sew on sleeves.

Circular needle 80 cm/ in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 66 – 72 – 78 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 68 – 71 – 74 cm/26.8-28-29.1 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 56 – 59 – 62 cm/22-23.2-24.4 in, bind off for neck edge 12 – 14 – 14 mid sts, and finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 4x1 st. When work measures approx. 62 – 65 – 68 cm/24.4-25.6-26.8 in, bind off.

Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

White, 300 4 5 6 balls

Circular needles 80 and 40 cm/ in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 42-46-54 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures 28 – 36 – 38 cm/11-14.2-15 in, bind off 3 sts at each edge. Leave work aside.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures 23 – 31 – 33 cm/9.1-12.2-13 in, bind off 3 sts at each edge. Leave work aside.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32 – 34 – 38 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and**

adjust across 1st row number of sts to be 33 – 35 – 37 sts. Inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 6 ½ – 8 – 7 ½ cm/2.6-3.1-3 in until you have 41-43-47 sts on a row, and sleeve measures approx. 31 – 36 – 42 cm/12.2-14.2-16.5 in Bind off 3 sts at each edge. Leave work aside, and knit the other sleeve.

YOKE

Slip all pieces on same circular needle size 7 mm = 142-154-178 sts on a rnd. Knit 1 rnd over all sts, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 130-140-160 sts. Work as foll: 10 – 11 – 13 rnds in St st, purl 1 rnd, 10 – 11 – 13 rnds in St st, **and** dec same time: After 4 – 5 – 6 rnds:: *K8, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Rep dec every 4th – 5th – 6th rnd with 1 st less between each dec alt. 2 times, every 4th rnd 0 – 1 – 1 time, every 3rd rnd 1 time, and then every 2nd rnd until 52-56-48 sts rem. Work 2 rnds in St st, and dec evenly across last rnd number of sts to be 44-46-48 sts. Knit 1 rnd, and 6 rnds in Garter st. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 5 – 6 – 7 cm/2-2.4-2.8 in on both sides. Sew sleeve seams.

Circular needle 80 and 40 cm/ in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm and black yarn, cast on 62-68-74 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures approx. 41 – 44 – 47 cm/16.1-17.3-18.5 in, bind off 4 sts at each edge. Leave work aside.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures 35 – 38 – 41 cm/13.8-15-16.1 in, bind off 4 sts at each edge. Leave work aside.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm and black yarn, cast on 40-40-44 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 7-6-7 cm/2.8-2.4-2.8 in until you have 52-54-56 sts on a row, and sleeve

measures approx. 46 – 48 – 48 cm/18.1-18.9-18.9 in. Bind off 4 sts at each edge. Leave work aside, and knit the other sleeve.

YOKE (read through before beginning to knit)

Slip all pieces on same circular needle size 7 mm = 196-212-228 sts on a rnd. Knit 1 rnd over all sts, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 180-200-210 sts. Change to light grey yarn, and work 2 rnds in Garter st over all sts. Work 20 rnds with dark grey yarn, **but** after 8 rnds dec as foll: *K8, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Rep dec every 8th rnd with 1 st less between each dec altog. 3 times, **but** after 20 rnds with dark grey, work 2 rnds in Garter st with black yarn, then 20 rnds with light grey yarn, **and** cont dec every 5th rnd 1 time, every 4th rnd 1 time, and then every 3rd rnd until 54-60-63 sts rem. Knit 3 rnds, and evenly across next rnd number of sts to be 48-52-54 sts. Work in Garter st 2 rnds with dark grey, and 4 rnds with black yarn. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-3.1-3.1 on both sides. Sew sleeve seams.

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Circular needle 80 cm/ in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 50 – 56 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 38 – 48 – 53 cm/15-18.9-20.9 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 22 – 26 – 28 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures approx. 28 – 38 – 43 cm/11-15-16.9 in, bind off first 5 – 5 – 6 sts for neck edge. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 3x1 st. When work measures approx. 33 – 43 – 48 cm/13-16.9-18.9 in, bind off.

Work same for the other front, rev all shaping.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32 – 36 – 38 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 5 ½

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 66 – 72 – 78 sts. Work 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 96 – 98 – 98 cm/38.8-38.6-38.6 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 34 – 36 – 40 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures approx. 52 – 54 – 54 cm/ 20.5-21.3-21.3 in, beg dec for V-neck. Dec 1 st inside selvage st approx. every 3 ½ - 3 ½ - 3 cm/1.4-1.4-1.2 in until 23 – 25 – 28 sts rem, and front measures approx. 90 – 92 – 92 cm/35.4-36.2-36.2 in. Bind off. Work same for the other front, rev all shaping.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seam. Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than fronts), and leave splits, approx. 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-3.1-3.1 in on both sides, for armholes approx. 25 – 26 – 28 cm/9.8-10.2-11 in.

inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 5 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-2.2 in until you have 42 – 48 – 52 sts on a row, and sleeve measures 31 – 36 – 42 cm/ in. Bind off.

Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Pockets: Using 2 needles size 7 mm, pick up 14 – 16 – 18 sts over, and 14 – 16 – 18 sts under extra yarn for pocket. Remove extra yarn. Note! Upper edge sts are worked downwards = back side of the pocket. Work in St st until pocket measures approx. 12 - 14 – 14 cm/4.7-5.5-5.5 in. Bind off.

Work K2,P2 rib with sts on the other needle. When edge measures approx. 4 cm/1.6 in, bind off in rib. Fold ribbed edge on RS, and sew short edges to the body.

Sew pockets on WS.

FRONT

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 22 – 26 – 28 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures approx. 17 – 19 – 19 cm/6.7-7.5-7.5 in, knit pocket sts with extra yarn: Work 4 – 5 – 5 sts, work next 14 – 16 – 18 sts with a length of different clr yarn, work rem 4 – 5 – 5 sts. Cont working back and forth in Garter st over all sts. When work measures approx. 36 – 46 – 50 cm/14.2-18.1-19.7 in, bind off first 5 – 5 – 6 sts for neck edge. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 3x1 st. When work measures approx. 41 – 51 – 55 cm/16.1-20.1-21.7 in, bind off.

Work same for the other front, rev al shaping.

SLEEVE

Rust, 362 5 6 7 balls

Circular needle 80 cm/, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 50 – 56 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 46 – 56 – 61 cm/18.1-22-24 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 36 – 46 – 50 cm/14.2-18.1-19.7 in, bind off for neck edge 10 – 10 – 12 mid sts, and finish each side separately. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 3x1 st. When work measures approx. 41 – 51 – 55 cm/16.1-20.1-21.7 in, bind off.

Work same for the other side, rev all shaping.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32 – 36 – 38 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 5 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-2.2 in until you have 42 – 48 – 52 sts on a row, and sleeve measures 31 – 36 – 42 cm/12.2-14.2-16.5 in. Bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 5 – 6 – 7 cm/2-2.4-2.8 in on both sides, for armholes approx. 18 – 20 – 22 cm/7.1-7.9-8.7 in.

COLLAR

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 54 – 60 – 64 sts. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 22 – 24 – 25 cm/8.7-9.4-9.8 in. Bind off.

Sew mid back seam, and sew collar along neck edge.

Sew sleeve seams. Sew on sleeves.

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 66 – 72 – 78 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st until work measures approx. 68 – 71 – 74 cm/26.8-28-29.1 in. Bind off.

FRONT

Using needles size 7mm, cast on 34 – 36 – 40 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures approx. 22 cm/8.7 in, knit pocket sts with extra yarn: Work 7 – 8 – 10 sts, Work next 18 sts with a length of different clr yarn, and work rem 8 – 9 – 11 sts. Cont working back and forth in Garter st over all sts. When work measures approx. 56 – 59 – 62 cm/22-23.2-24.4 in, bind off first 6 – 7 – 7 sts for neck edge. Bind off at neck edge every 2nd row 4x1 st. When work measures approx. 62 – 65 – 68 cm/24.4-25.6-26.8 in, bind off.

Work same for the other front, rev all shaping.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 46 – 48 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 4 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-1.8 in until you have 60 – 62 – 68 sts on a row, and sleeve measures 46 – 48 – 48 cm/18.1-18.9-18.9 in. Bind off. Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than fronts), and leave splits, approx. 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-3.1-3.1 in on both sides, for armholes approx. 25 – 26 – 28 cm/9.8-10.2-11 in. Sew sleeve seams. Sew on sleeves.

Pockets: Using 2 needles size 7 mm, pick up 18 sts over, and 18 sts under extra yarn for pocket. Remove extra yarn. Note: Upper

edge sts are worked downwards = back of the pocket. Work in St st until pocket measures approx. 16 cm/6.3 in. Bind off Work K2,P2 rib with sts on the other needle. When edge measures 4 cm/1.6 in, bind off in rib. Fold ribbed edge on RS, and sew short edges to the body. Sew pockets on WS.

BACK

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 50 – 56 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures 28 – 36 – 38 cm/11-14.2-15 in, bind off 3 sts at each edge. Dec 1 st beg of each row for raglan. Rep dec until 12 – 12 – 14 sts rem. Bind off.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures 23 – 31 – 33 cm/9.1-12.2-13 in, bind off 3 sts at each edge. Dec for raglan same as for back.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 32 – 36 – 38 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 5 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-2.2 in until you have 42 – 48 – 52 sts on a row, and sleeve measures approx. 31 – 36 – 42 cm/ in. Bind off 3 sts at each edge. Dec 1 st beg of each row for raglan. Rep dec until 10 – 10 – 10 sts rem. Bind off.

Work same for other sleeve.

FINISHING

Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave spits, approx. 5 – 6 – 7 cm/2.4-2.8 in on both sides. Sew sleeve seams. Sew raglan-seams, and underarm seams.

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 66 – 72 – 78 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st. When work measures approx. 43 – 44 – 46 cm/16.9-17.3-18.1 in, bind off 4 sts at each edge. Dec 1 st beg of each row for raglan. Rep dec until 16 – 18 – 18 sts rem. Bind off.

FRONT

Work same as for back. When work measures 37 – 38 – 40 cm/14.6-15-15.7 in, work raglan-dec same as for back.

SLEEVES

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 44 – 46 – 48 sts. Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K2,P2 rib. Cont working in Garter st, **and** inc 1 st at each edge approx. every 5 ½ – 5 ½ – 4 ½ cm/2.2-2.2-1.8 in until you have 60 – 62 – 68 sts, and sleeve measures approx. 46 – 48 – 48 cm/18.1-18.9-18.9 in. Bind off 4 sts at each edge. Dec 1 st beg of each row for raglan. Rep dec until 10 – 8 – 8 sts rem. Bind off.

Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Sew side seams (Note: Back is longer than front), and leave splits, approx. 7 – 8 – 8 cm/2.8-3.1-3.1 in on both sides. Sew sleeve seams. Sew raglan-seams, and underarm seams.

Size 4 6-8 10-12 yrs

ALTERNATIVE YARNS: Viking Mohair (78% mohair, 13% wool, 9% nylon), Viking Alpaca Superfine (100% alpaca superfine), Viking Naturgarn (100% wool) 50 g ball, Viking Balder (100% wool, superwash) 100 g skein

White, 300:	1	1	1 ball
Beige, 307:	1	1	1 ball

Circular needle 60 and 40 cm/ in, size 7 mm – US 10½ or 11 – UK/Canadian 2

Gauge: 12 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 7 mm. **Check your gauge to ensure success.**

Beg from lower edge. Using needles size 7 mm and beige yarn, cast on 120 – 136 – 152 sts. Work 5 rnds in Garter st. Change to white yarn, and work 12 rnds in St st, purl 1 rnd, and cont after that working in St st, **and** beg dec after 2 rnds with white yarn: *K6, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Rep dec every 4th rnd with 1 st less between each dec until 45 – 51 – 57 sts rem. Knit 3 rnds, and dec evenly across last rnd number of sts to be 44 – 46 – 48 sts. Work 6 rnds in Garter st. Bind off.

Wristwarmers

Using needles size 7 mm and beige yarn, cast on 18 – 20 – 22 sts. Work back and forth 16 rows in Garter st. Change to white yarn, and cont working in St st. After 5 cm/2 in in St st, bind off for thumb, knit 5 sts, bind off 3sts, knit rem sts. Next row: Cast on 3 sts over the bound-off sts. When work measures 14 – 15 – 16 cm/5.5-5.9-6.3 in, work 4 rows in Garter st. Bind off.

Finishing: Sew side seam.
