SWEATER

Using needles size 5¹/₂ mm and black (brown for woman), cast on 136-148-160-176 sts. Work in rnds 7 cm/2.8 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 6 mm, and cont working in rnds in St st. Place markers each side, 69-75-81-89 sts for front and 67-73-79-87 sts for back. When work measures approx. 46-46-47-46 cm/18.1-18.1-18.5-18.1 in, bind off 8 sts at each side (4 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit the sleeves.


Sleeves

Using needles size 51/2 mm and off-white (brown for woman) yarn, cast on 36-38-40-40 sts. Work in rnds 7 cm/2.8 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 6 mm, and cont working in St st. Inc evenly across 1st rnd number of sts to be 43-45-47-49 sts. Work patt II as charted, and after that cont in St st with black (brown foe woman).Place a marker mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every 5-5-5- $4\frac{1}{2}$ cm/2-2-2-1.8 in until there is altog. 59-63-65-69 sts on a rnd. Cont working until sleeve measures the given length, or as desired. Bind off 8 sts mid under sleeve (4 sts both sides of the marker). Work same for the other sleeve.

Yoke: Slip all pieces on same circular needle, with sleeves over the bound-off sts = 222-242-258-282 sts on a rnd.

Knit 1 rnd, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 216-240-256-280 sts.

Cont working in rnds in patt I and dec as charted until 81-90-96-105 sts rem. Keep rep last patt as charted until work measures approx. 67-68-70-70 cm/26.4-26.8-27.6-27.6 in (or patt measures approx. 2-3-4-4 cm/0.8-1.2-1.6-1.6 in). Work 1 rnd in St st with off-white yarn, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 76-78-80-80 sts. Work in rnds 6-6-7-7 cm/2.4-2.4-2.8-2.8 in in K1,P1 rib. Bind off in rib. Fold neck edge in double, and sew on WS. Sew under arm seams. Weave in all ends on WS.

Back

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 82-90-96-104-112 sts. Work back and forth 4 rows in Garter st. Cont working in patt I as charted, rep 2 times. Work in St st (knit 1st and last sts every row = selvage st). When work measures approx. 4-3-4-3-4 cm/1.6-1.2-1.6-1.2-1.6 in, dec 1 st at each edge inside selvage sts, beg of row: K2tog; end of row: K2togtbl. Rep dec every 5 ½ cm2.2/ in (same for all sizes) altog. 10 times = 62-70-76-84-92 sts rem. When work measures approx. 59-58-59-58-59 cm/23.2 in, bind off for armholes at each edge on every 2nd row: 1x4 sts, 1-1-2-2-2x2 sts, and 1-1-1-2-2x1 st = 48-56-58-64-72 sts rem. Cont working until work measures approx. 80-80-82-82-84 cm/31.5-31.5-32.3-32.3-33.1 in. Bind off.

Right front

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 32-34-36-38-40 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Beg from RS (from front edge) and inc 7 sts over first 14 sts (= 21 sts) = patt II, and end with St st over 18-20-22-24-26 sts (knit last st = selvage st). There is now 39-41-43-45-47 sts on a row. Cont working back and forth as established, and dec 1 st inside selvage st same as for back. When work measures 59-58-59-58-59 cm/23.2-22.8-23.2-22.8-23.2 in, bind off for armhole same as for back. When front measures same as back, dec on last RS-row evenly across cable patt st to be 14 sts.

Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

Sleeves

Using needles size $5\frac{1}{2}$ mm, cast on 36-36-38-38-40 sts. Work 4 rows in Garter st. Cont working in rnds in patt I as charted, rep 4 times. Place a marker mid under sleeve. Cont working in St st, and inc 1 st both sides of the marker approx. every $3\frac{1}{2} - 3-3-3-3 \text{ cm}/1.4-1.2-1.2-1.2-1.2$ in until there is altog. 60-62-66-68-70 sts on a rnd. When work measures approx. 50-50-52-52-53 cm/19.7-19.7-20.5-20.5-20.9 in, bind off mid under sleeve 6 sts (3 sts both sides of the marker). Cont working back and forth, and bind off at each edge every 2^{nd} row 1-1-2-2.2x2 sts, and 1-1-1-2-2x1 st. Bind off rem sts. Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING


Sew shoulder seams and side seams. Shawl collar:

Using 2 circular needles 80 cm/31.5 in size 6 mm, nr 6, pick along right front until mid back neck edge approx. 120-120-124-124-126 sts, and cont picking along same amount of sts along mid back neck edge and left front edge on another circular needle size 6 mm = approx. 240-240-248-248-252 sts. <u>Note!</u> Work in patt I until the edge is ready. Cont as foll:

Break yarn, and beg from mid back. Work 8 sts over left side, turn, work 16 sts, turn, work 18 sts, turn, work 20 sts. Cont working in the same way, 2 sts more at each side until there is approx. 104-104-108-108-112 sts on a row. Cont working over all sts until the edge measures approx. 10 cm/4 in (measured from the lower edge). Bind off rather loosely.

Sew on sleeves. Weave in all ends on WS.



When work measures approx. 24-31-39 cm/9.4-12.2-15.4 in, bind off 6-6-8 sts at each side (3-3-4 sts both sides of the markers). Leave work aside, and knit the sleeves.

Sleeves

Using needles size $5\frac{1}{2}$ mm and off-white yarn, cast on 22-24-28 sts. Work in rnds 5-5-6 cm/2-2-2.4 in in K1,P1 rib. Change to needles size 6 mm. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 27-31-33 sts. Work patt II as charted, and cont after that in St st with grey yarn. Place a marker mid under sleeve. Inc 1 st both sides of the marker every 4-4-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ cm/1.6-1.6-1.8 in until there is altog. 39-45-49 sts on a rnd. Work until sleeve measures the given length or as desired. Bind off 6-6-8 sts mid under sleeve (3-3-4 sts both sides of the marker). Slip rem sts on holder. Work same for the other sleeve.

Yoke: Slip all pieces over same circular needle. Place sleeves over the bound-off sts for armholes = 142-170-178sts on a rnd. Knit 1 rnd over all sts, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 136-160-168 sts. Work 0-2-4 rnds in St st with grey yarn. Cont working in rnds in patt I, and dec as charted until 68-80-90 sts rem on a rnd. Rep last rows of patt as charted until work measures approx. 38-47-56 cm/ 15-18.5-22 in. Work 1 rnd in St st with white yarn, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 54-60-64 sts. Cont working in K1,P1 rib and off-white yarn until neck band measures approx. 6-6-7 cm/2.4-2.4-2.8 in. Bind off rather loosely in rib. Fold neck band in double, and sew on WS. Sew under arm seams, an weave in all ends on WS.

Seed st as charted. Place markers each side, 71-75-83-87-95 sts for back, and 31-33-37-39-43 sts for each front. Cont working until work measures approx. 85-89-88-87-86 cm/33.5-35-34.6-34.3-33.9 in. Bind off 8 sts at each side (4 sts both sides of the markers). Finish back and fronts separately.

Back

Cont working in Seed st. Bind off at each edge every 2^{nd} row 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1 st. Cont working until work measures the given length, or as desired. Bind off.

Right front

Work same as for back. When work measures approx. 97-102-102-102 cm/38.2-40.2-40.2-40.2-40.2 in, bind off for neck edge every 2^{nd} row 1x6-6-6-7-7 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1 st. When front measures same as back, bind off.

Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

Sleeves

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 39-41-43-43-45 sts. Work back and forth in Seed st. Inc 1 st at each edge approx. every $5\frac{1}{2}-5\frac{1}{2}-5-4\frac{1}{2}-4\frac{1}{2}$ cm/2.2-2.2-2-1..8-1.8 in until there is altog. 57-59-63-65-67 sts. When sleeve measures 50-51-52-52-53 cm/19.7-20.1-20.5-20.5-20.9 in (or desired length), bind off at each edge every 2^{nd} row 1x4 sts, 1x3 sts, 1x2 sts, and 1x1 st. Bind off rem sts. Work same for the other sleeve. sew sleeve seams.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Right front edge: Using needles size 6 mm, pick or knit up approx.124-132-132-132 sts (Note! Number of sts must be multiple with 8+4 sts). Work back and forth 4 cm/1.6 in in K4,P4 rib. Bind off rather loosely (take care that the edge doesn't turn to be too tight). Work same for left front edge.

Collar/neck band: Beg from right front edge, and pick or knit up approx. 62-66-66-70-70 sts (Note! Number of sts must be multiple with 4+2 sts). Work back and forth in K2,P2 rib until neck band measures approx. 5 cm/2 in. Inc now 1 st to each knit- and purl stripe. Cont working in K3,P3 rib, until neck and measures approx. 10 cm/4 in. Rep inc, and cont working in K4,P4 rib, until collar measures approx. 15 cm/5.9 in. Bind off rather loosely in rib.

Pockets

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 28 sts. Work 6 rows in K4,P4 rib. Purl 1 row from WS, and dec evenly across number of sts to be 21 sts. Cont working back and forth in Seed st until work measures approx. 18 cm/7.1 in. Bind off, knit sts knitwise, purl sts purlwise.

Work same for the other pocket.

Sew on pockets approx. 2 cm/0.8 in from front edges, on desired height.

Sew on sleeves, and weave in all ends on WS. If desired, sew on clasps on front.

Using needles size $5\frac{1}{2}$ mm and grey yarn, cast on 159-165-177-187 sts. Work back and forth 3 cm/1.2 in in K1,P1 rib. Slip first and last 8 sts on holders= front ands, worked later on = 143-149-161-171 sts on a row. Place markers at each side, 35-36-39-42 sts for each front, and 73-77-83-87 sts for back. Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working back and forth (or in rnds) in St st and patt over rem sts. When work measures approx. 37-38-40-40 cm/14.6-15-15.7-15.7 in, beg dec for V-neck. Dec1 st at each edge inside selvage st. Rep dec approx. every 3 cm/1.2 in, but when work measures approx. 46-46-47-46 cm/18.1-18.1-18.5-18.1 in, divide work at sidemarkers (Note! Only when work back and forth), and finish back and fronts separately.

Back

Cont working back and forth in patt until work measures given length or as desired. Bind off.

Right front

Cont working back and forth in patt, and rep V-neck dec altog.10-10-10-10 times. When front measures same as back, bind off.

Work same for left front, rev all shaping.

Sleeves

Using needles size $5\frac{1}{2}$ mm, cast on 36-38-40-40 sts. Work back and forth 3 cm/ in in K1tbl,P1 rib. Place a marker mid under sleeve. Change to needles size 7 mm. Cont working in St st and patt as charted. Inc 1st both sides of the markers approx. every $4-4 - 4 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ cm/1.6-1.6-1.6-1.4 in until there is altog. 58-62-64-68 sts on a rnd. When sleeve measures given length, or as desired, bind off (end with a complete stripe).

Note! If you have worked the body in rnds, turn sleeve inside out, and work 5 rnds in St st for seam allowance. Bind off.

Work same for the other sleeve.

FINISHING

Note! If you have worked the cardigan in rnds, sew dense zigzag seams mid front, and around armholes. Cut open between seams.


Sew shoulder seams.

Front band: Slip 8 sts from holder over needles size 5½ mm. **Note! If you have worked in rnds, cast on 4 extra sts to the edge facing the body = seam allowance, worked in St st.** Cont working in K1,P1 rib until front

Turn, and always knit first st of the row. Rep inc until there is 64 - 74 - 84 sts on a row. Leave work aside, and knit same for another piece.

Slip all sts on same circular needle size 6 mm = 128 - 148 - 168 sts on a rnd. Place markers at each side. Cont working in rnds in Garter st. When work measures approx. 30 cm/11.8 in (measured from markers), slip 8 sts at each side on holder (4 sts both sides of the markers = shoulder piece). Finish each side separately.

Back: Cont working back and forth in Garter st, **and bind** off at each edge every 2^{nd} row 1 - 2 - 0x4 sts, 1 - 1 - 2x5 sts, 1 - 1 - 1x6 sts and 0 - 0 - 1x7 sts. Slip rem 26 - 28 - 30 sts on holder.

Front: Work same as for back.

Shoulder pieces: Slip 8 sts from holder on needles size 6 mm. Work back and forth in Garter st until work measures approx. 10 - 13 - 16 cm/4-5.1-6.3 in (or it's as long as the bound-off sts. Take care that shoulder piece must not be too long). Slip sts on holder.

Work same for the other shoulder piece.

Neck band: Slip all sts on same circular needle size $5\frac{1}{2}$ mm = 68 - 72 - 76 sts. Work in rnds approx. 12 cm/4.7 in in K2,P2 rib. Bind off in rib.

Sew shoulder pieces to the body.

HAT

Using needles size 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm, cast on 72 – 76 – 80 sts. Work in rnds approx. 4 cm/1.6 in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 6 mm. Work in Garter st until work measures approx. 18 - 20 - 22 cm/7.1-7.9-8.7 in. End with 1 purl-rnd. Dec for crown: Knit all sts tog in pairs. Purl 1 rnd. Rep dec every 2nd rnd until 9 – 10 – 10 sts rem. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts. Tighten the yarn, and weave in on WS.

Pompom

Note: Keep yarn tight so that sts don't fall down from needles.

Using needles size 8 mm and Fox4You, cast on 4 sts. Knit 1 row, and inc number of sts to be 8 sts. Next row: Inc number of sts to 16 sts, and divide sts on 4 dpn. Knit 1 rnd. Next rnd: Inc number of sts to 24 sts. Knit 4 rnds. Next rnd: Dec number of sts to16 sts. Knit 1 rnd. Dec number of sts to 8 sts. Last rnd: Knit all sts tog in pairs = 4 sts. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts.

Sew a big snap fastener to pompom, and fasten on top of the hat.

Weave in all ends on WS

It is advised to remove Fox4you-pompom before washing the hat.

Using needles size 7 mm and off-white yarn, cast on 18 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st. After 2 rows inc as foll: 2x2 sts and 10x1 st. Work 2 rows in Garter st. Inc 1x1 st. Work 2 rows in Garter st, and inc 1x1 st = 50 sts. Work after last inc 88 rows in Garter st.

Dec now : 1x1 st, work 2 rows in Garter st. Dec 1x1 st, work 2 rows in Garter st. Dec 10x1 st. and 2x2sts = 18 sts on a row. Bind off.

HEAD

Using needle size 7 mm and dark grey yarn, cast on 4 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st. After 2 rows beg inc: 2x2 sts, and 1x1 st. Work 2 rows in Garter st. *Inc 1 st, work 6 rows in Garter st*, rep *-* 5 times. Inc 4x1 st. Cast on for ears 1x7 sts, and 4x2 sts. Work 2 rows in Garter st over all sts. Next row: K18, K2tog, K2tog, K18, K2tog, K2tog and K18. Knit 1 row. K18, K2tog, K18, K2tog, and K18. Knit 1 row. Bind off.

LEGS

Using needles size 7 mm and dark grey yarn, cast on 2 sts and inc 2x1 st = 6 sts. Work back and forth 24 rows in Garter st. Bind off. Knit same for 3 more legs. FINISHING

Sew on head and legs before felting.

FELTING: Hobbygarn felts a lot. Use 30-40°C fine wash program, max 40min. Test first with a swatch. Shape garment while still damp.

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 2 sts. Work back and forth in Garter st. After 2 rows, inc as foll: 2x1 st, 17x2 sts = 74 sts on a row. Inc 11x1 st. Work 2 rows in Garter st. Inc1x1 st = 98 sts. Work 16 rows over all sts. Dec now : 1x1 st. 2 rows in Garter st. Dec 11x1 st. Divide work into 2 parts, 37 sts for each side. Finish each side separately. Cont dec 1x1 st, 5x2 sts and 1x4 sts = 7 sts rem. Bind odd.

Work same for the other side.

FELTING: Hobbygarn felts a lot. Use 30-40°C fine wash program, max. 40 min. Test first with a swatch. Shape garment while still damp.

PONCHO

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 170 sts. Work 24 rnds in Garter st. Cont working in patt A, rep 2 times. Cont working in St st, and dec as foll: *K8, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Rep dec every 2^{nd} rnd with 1 st less between dec until 68 sts rem. Work 1 rnd in St st. Work in rnds 12 cm/ in in Garter st. Bind off.

Twist a cord, approx. 110 cm/43.3 in long. Thread cord through neck band. Make 2 pom-poms, and fasten one to each end.

HAT

Using needles size 7 mm, cast on 60 - 64 - 68 sts. Work 24 rnds in Garter st. Cont working in patt A until hat measures approx. 26 cm/10.2 in. Beg dec for crown: Knit all sts tog in pairs. Knit 1 rnd. Rep dec every 2^{nd} rnd until 8 – 8 - 9 sts rem. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts. Tighten the yarn slightly, and weave in on WS. Fasten a large pom-pom on top.

SCARF

Using dark violet yarn, cast on 56 sts. Work in rnds 12 cm/4.7 in in K2,P2 rib. Place 8 markers across the rnd, 6 sts between each marker. Cont working in rnds in St st, and inc 1 st both sides of the markers every 4^{th} rnd 2 times, and then every 2^{nd} rnd 3 times, **same time** work with stripes as foll: 4 rnds with dark violet, 2 rnds with light violet, 2 rnds

with off-white, 2 rnds with dark violet, 2 rnds with light violet, 2 rnds with off-white. Cont working with light violet until scarf is ready. When there is 136 sts on a rnd, dec marked sts one by one (= dec altog. 8 sts). Work the lower edge in pieces in St st (knit first and last 2 sts every row = selvage sts). Dec beg of each row as foll: K2, K2togtbl (WS: P2tog) . Work until 5 sts rem, K1, sl 1,K2tog, psso, K1 = 3 sts. Turn, and dec on last row as foll: Slip 1 sts, K2tog,psso. Break yarn, draw through last st, and weave in on WS. Work same for rest of the lower edge sts.

HAT

Using needles size 6 mm and dark violet yarn, cast on 60 sts. Work 10 cm/4 in in K2,P2 rib. Work 1 rnd in St st, and inc evenly across number of sts to be 64 sts. Work in stripes as foll: 2 rnds with light violet, 2 rnds with off-white, 2 rnds with dark violet, 2 rnds in light violet, and 2 rnds in off-white. Cont working with light violet. When work measures approx. 20 cm/7.9 in, dec for crown every 2^{nd} rnd as foll: *K2, K2tog*, rep *-* across the rnd. Next dec rnd: Same, but with 1 st less between dec until 32 sts rem. Next de rnd: Knit all sts tog in pairs. Knit 1 rnd, and rep last dec = 8 sts. Break yarn, and thread through rem sts. Tighten the yarn, and weave in on WS.

Gauge: 14 sts = approx. 10 cm/4 in over St st using needles size 6 mm. Check your gauge to ensure success.

HAT

Using needles size 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm, cast on 64 – 68 sts. Work in rnds approx. 7-8 cm/2.8-3.1 in in K2,P2 rib. Change to needles size 6 mm, and cont working in St st. When hat measures approx. 24-26 cm/9.4-10.2 in, dec for crown: Knit all sts tog in pairs. Work 1 rnd in St st. Rep dec until 16-17 sts rem. Knit 1 rnd, and rep dec = 8 – 9 sts on a rnd. Break yarn, and thread it through rem sts. Tighten the yarn slightly, and weave in on WS. Make a large pom-pom, and fasten on top.

SCARF

Using needles size 6 mm, cast on 42 - 52 sts. Work in rnds in St st until work measures approx. 150 - 160 cm/59-63 in, or until all yarn is finished. (Note! Check that there will be enough yarn left for fringes). Bind off.

If you wish, you can tie approx. 12 fringes using double yarn to each end. Tie fringes through both edges. Length of fringes is approx. 12 cm/4.7 in.
